Local Housing Allowance - Size Criteria

Your Local Housing Allowance (LHA) rate will depend on how many people live in your household.

Allow one bedroom for:

- Every adult couple (married or unmarried)
- Any other adult aged 16 or over
- Any two children of the same sex aged under 16
- Any two children regardless of sex aged under 10
- Any other child (under 16)

If you make a new claim after 6 April 2009, the maximum LHA rate payable is the 5 bedroom rate only.

- Most single claimants under 25 years old will only be entitled to the 1 bedroom shared LHA rate (category A)
- Single claimants over 25 years old and couples with no dependant children will be entitled to the 1 bedroom self contained LHA rate (category B) providing they have exclusive use of other facilities such as a their own bathroom, toilet and kitchen/cooking facilities or exclusive use of at least two rooms (counting only bedrooms and living rooms).

Please note this is the maximum amount of LHA you will get – your actual benefit may be less depending on the amount of money you have coming in and if other adults apart from your partner live with you
