issues, investigations into criminal conduct including such relevant provisions of the Local Government Act of 1972 and 2000 and investigate criminal matters, institute or defend such legal proceedings on behalf of other local authorities);

- 7) Exercise the Council's powers and duties relating to the registration of births, marriages and deaths, save for the review or setting of fees and charges relating to the same; and
- 8) Deal with any matters relating to the caravan sites, the security industry, Anti-Social Behaviour and dogs legislation.

## and

- d. Subject to open and transparent arrangements being provided may be permitted to subdelegate any of their powers, functions and duties to any staff within their respective areas of responsibility.
- e. Enter into any agreements, memorandum of understanding or protocols with other local authorities and other public bodies in respect of joint, partnership or service provision arrangements (including providing services and where appropriate charging for such services).
- f. The Director of Legal and Democratic Services (Monitoring Officer) delegates the issuing of legal proceedings in respect of all licensing and regulatory matters to the Strategic Director of Homes and Neighbourhoods and notes and approves the sub-delegation in this document to the Director of Regulation and Enforcement.
