### ***Multi Agency Public Protection Arrangements***

Please provide the details for people being dealt with under the Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements system which includes:

- Category 1: Registered Sex Offenders (RSOs),
- Category 2: All offenders who have received a custodial sentence of 12 months or more in prison for a sexual or violent offence and whilst they remain under Probation supervision.
- Category 3: Anyone else who poses a "risk of serious harm to the public" who has received a conviction and whose risk would be better managed in a multi-agency setting.

Who have been moved from outside the Birmingham area into it as outlined in the original question? Can I have the numbers for 2010 and 2011 please, and separate numbers for each category (e.g. xx category 1 etc).

The information we are able to provide is regarding those applications that are subject to MAPPA (Multi Agency Public Protection Arrangements) and have made their application from an address outside Birmingham
