## Booking lessons and treks.

To book a lesson or trek please contact the centre manager on ☎-0121-422-3464.

Sessions are very popular so it's advisable to book at least a week in advance. When booking please have the following information:-

1. Name of the child or adult
2. Age or height and weight  
(Max 11 ½ stone, essential for pony allocation)
3. What riding experience if any
4. Any special needs or requirements.

## Clothing and Footwear

We recommend that you wear comfortable clothing. A track suit is ideal as it provides protection for the arms and legs from scratches and insect bites. It is not advisable to wear vest tops, skirts, shorts or anything tight fitting.

For Intermediate and Experienced riders we recommend that you purchase your own riding hat, boots and Jodhpurs as these will increase rider safety and comfort. A body protector is also recommended to protect against the inevitable falls.

It is essential that riders wear shoes or boots with a small heel. For your own safety you will not be permitted to ride in trainers or open shoes / sandals.

The trekking centre will provide each rider with a riding hat.

**NB Any bookings may be cancelled at short notice if the weather is very severe.**



## How to find us.

Hole Farm Trekking Centre is located within the Woodgate Valley Country Park, Bartley Green, Birmingham. From the car park take the tarmac path past the entrance to the urban farm and on towards a wooden pedestrian gate (entrance beyond this point is for booked in riders only) head through the gate and into the trekking centre yard.

### By car

#### From Birmingham City Centre

Follow the Hagley road (A456) west towards the M5 and Quinton at the junction with the A4123 follow the signs for Woodgate Valley Country Park.

#### From the M5 junction 3

Take the A456 towards Halesowen and take the first exit left (Lapal Lane South). Head up this road and turn left over the motorway into Lye Close Lane. At the junction with Carters Lane turn right and at the roundabout left into Clapgate Lane. The Car park entrance is a short distance on the left.

**Car parking is free of charge.**

### By bus

The West midlands travel number 23 stops opposite the Visitor Centre on Clapgate Lane.
