



A one day course for Teachers working with Pupils with Hearing Loss run by the Hearing Support Team

Details of Course

This course aims to:

- Enable participants to understand the impact of hearing loss on development and learning
- Examine a range of strategies to support learning and development
- Provide teachers, required to have a working knowledge of audiological equipment, with the skills to support pupils effectively.

Course Structure

Course delivery will be a combination of direct tuition and practical workshops. There will be opportunities for group discussion.

Outcomes

Teachers will have:

- High expectations of pupils with hearing loss in their class
- Strategies for differentiation of the curriculum to promote pupil progress, plus strategies to promote the development of communication, language and literacy skills
- An understanding of Hearing Aids, Radio Aids and Cochlear Implants and be confident in use of this audiological equipment.
