Details of Course

The aim of this one day course is to enable participants to understand the implications of visual impairment upon a pupil's learning within a school setting. There will be opportunities to examine ways of meeting needs that arise from these impairments.

Course Structure

Course delivery will be a combination of direct tuition and practical experiences. There will be opportunities for group discussion and paired work.

Outcomes

By the end of the course participants will:

- have a greater understanding of impaired 'vision' and its impact upon learning
- be aware of the implication of impaired vision in a school context
- be aware of strategies, approaches and equipment that will maximise learning and progress for pupils with a visual impairment.
