This has seen 12 schools benefit from circa £1m of interest free loans and council contributions to get new energy efficiency and energy generation equipment. Half of the schools have now got solar PV arrays (picture above from Little Sutton), five schools have got new boilers, and all schools have had new LED fittings installed. Hear first hand from SEEP Tranche 1 schools how, together, we will achieve circa £85K of savings per year, including free electricity & income from Solar PV. The contractor, SSE, will also be there to discuss what other energy efficiency measures we can incorporate this year.
