


New DfE secure login


The DfE have introduced a new 'Sign in' to replace secure access, this is how you can access Collect and Key to Success portals. You will not be able to complete Spring school census without updating your access to Collect.




Click "I need to migrate my Secure Access account to DfE Sign-in" and you'll see this screen:







Click the continue button.




Select the merge option unless you want to use a different email account and click on continue




