





Case Study

Cava Security Services Ltd



A rapidly-growing security services company based in Redditch has become the 500th business to be supported by the Business Growth Programme, a £33m programme designed to help firms in the region with their growth plans.

Cava Security Services Ltd was established in 2005 and soon established a track-record in providing high-quality security services across a wide variety of industries, including key holding, patrolling and site security.

Having experienced increased turnover over the past six years, Cava Security Services wanted to diversify and expand their business, but with the company operating out of two separate sites, it needed to make efficiencies by migrating its services into larger premises.

Cava Security Services Ltd sought to expand the CCTV Monitoring service and invested in a concept CCTV control room that functions as a unilateral operating system, significantly improving efficiencies in cost and time. A grant of £20,000 from the Business Growth Programme was used to renovate existing office space and purchase the necessary equipment to construct the control room. As a result of this expansion, two new jobs were created.
