

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(A) THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 6, GRAVELLY HILL) (LINK ROADS) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2014

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the City of Birmingham, to allow parapet wall repairs and resurfacing work to be carried out.

The effect of the order will be to close the link roads at Junction 6 of the M6, leading from:-

1) the southbound carriageway of the M6 to Salford Circus;

2) the southbound carriageway of the M6 to the A38(M) Access Expressway; and

3) the northbound carriageway of the M6 to Salford Circus.

The work will be carried out overnight between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Saturday 4 October 2014 and continue for one week. The Order will come into force on Monday 29 September 2014.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigades or ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the work or by a traffic officer will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via the M6 Junction 4, return northbound to Junction 6, then A38(M), A5127 Lechliffe Road and Salford Circus will be signed.

The Bridge School

The Bridge School is a community special school for 73 pupils from the age of 7 - 11 years. The school educates children with complex and multiple needs including severe learning difficulties, profound and multiple learning difficulties and autism. The school also provides specialist support for children with physical disabilities. The school is a member of the Birmingham City Council's Special Schools Partnership.

The proposed alteration is to relocate the Bridge School to one site on Longmore Campus from 1st January 2015 and close the site at 250 Reserve Road Erdington (the school will become a single site school). The school is a boarding provision on the Longmore campus. There are no boarders currently in the boarding provision. It is proposed for the school to:

• Remove the boarding provision at The Bridge School - Longmore Campus, Copple View Road, Sutton Coldfield, Birmingham B73 6UE from 31st December 2014.
