BRITISH COUNCIL VISIT TO CHINA, 05-10 NOVEMBER 2019

Would you like to set up pupil visits to a partner school in China but don't yet have a partner school?

Join our fully funded visit to Kunming or Fuzhou, where you will get the chance to meet with a partner school and plan a pupil visit (using the DFE funding for International School Exchanges Programme https://www.britishcouncil.org/school-resources/exchanges).

Who is eligible	 Secondary schools teachers from state schools in England (not independent schools) Don't need to be teaching Mandarin One or two teachers per school can attend this event
How will the visit work	 Travel, accommodation, meals, visa costs all covered All arrangements will be made by the British Council Meet Chinese teachers and build partnerships Visit a school in China Understand more about education approaches in China Draft programme: Arrival on 05 November Paralleled Programmes in Kunming and Fuzhou on 06-08 November (including seminar, school and cultural visit) Departure on 09 November
You need to	 Have the approval of your headteacher Be committed to carrying out a student exchange Ready to apply for up to £15,500 funding for the exchange, by 14th February 2020, with Exchange Visit to China with students to take place before 31st May 2020. Have plans to include the most disadvantaged pupils (who would not normally have this opportunity) in the visit and in the partnership Agree to accept a return visit at some point at your school by the partner school from China.
