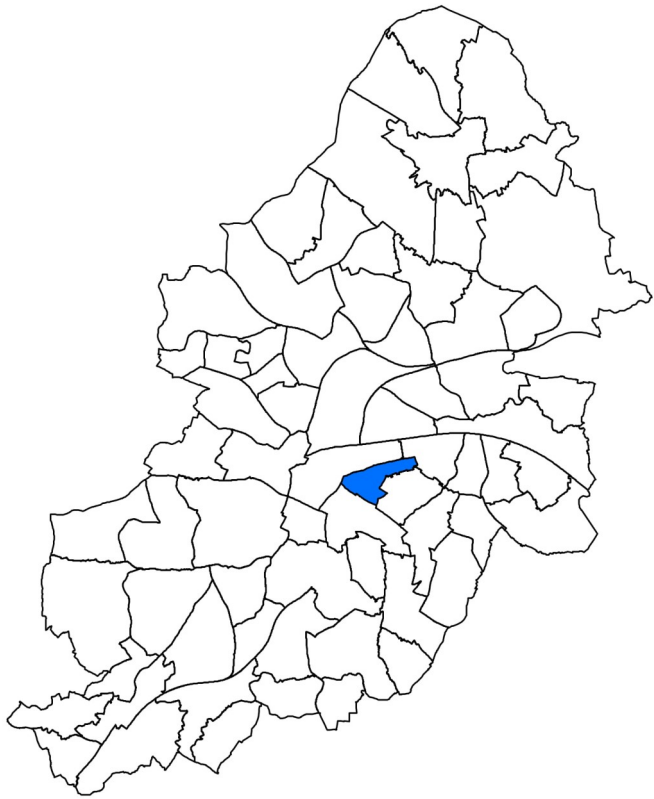


Bordesley Green Ward Factsheet

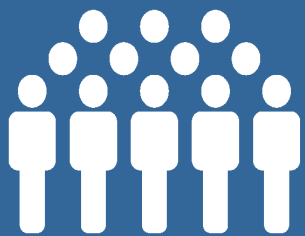


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Bordesley Green Ward is an inner city ward located to the south east of the city centre. It has a population of 11,796 making it the 39th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and has a higher BAME population share.

Bordesley Green is amongst the most deprived wards in the city and has the 7th lowest average income. Resident employment rates in the ward are much lower than the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well above the Birmingham average.

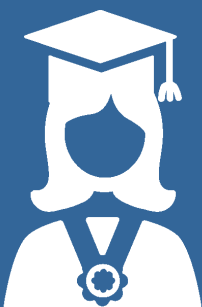

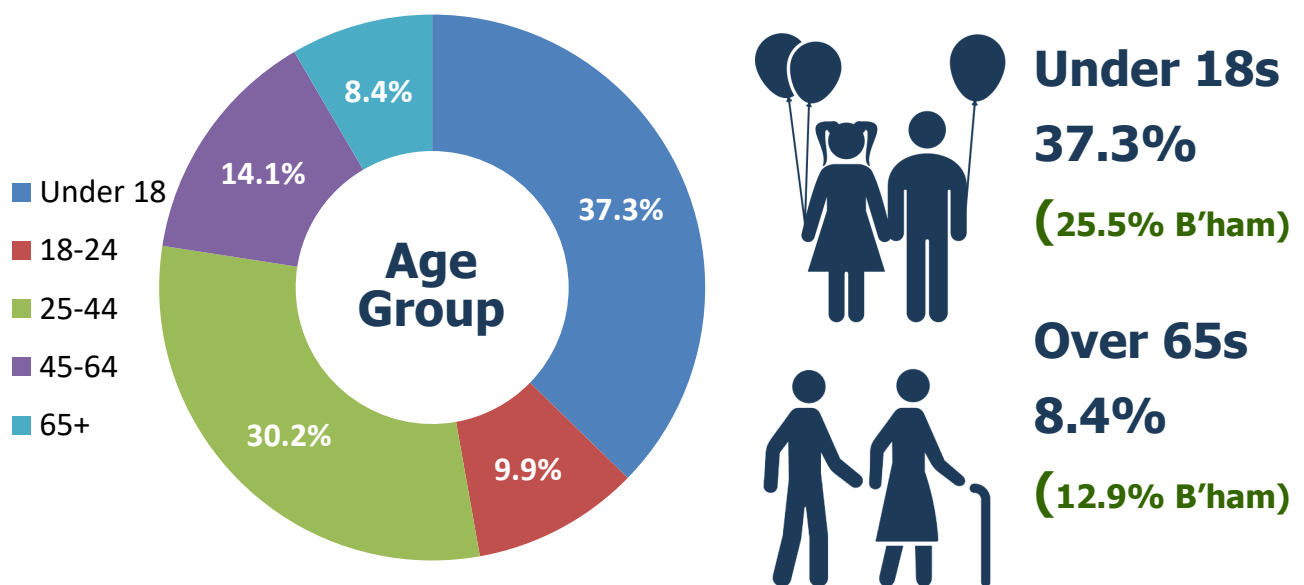

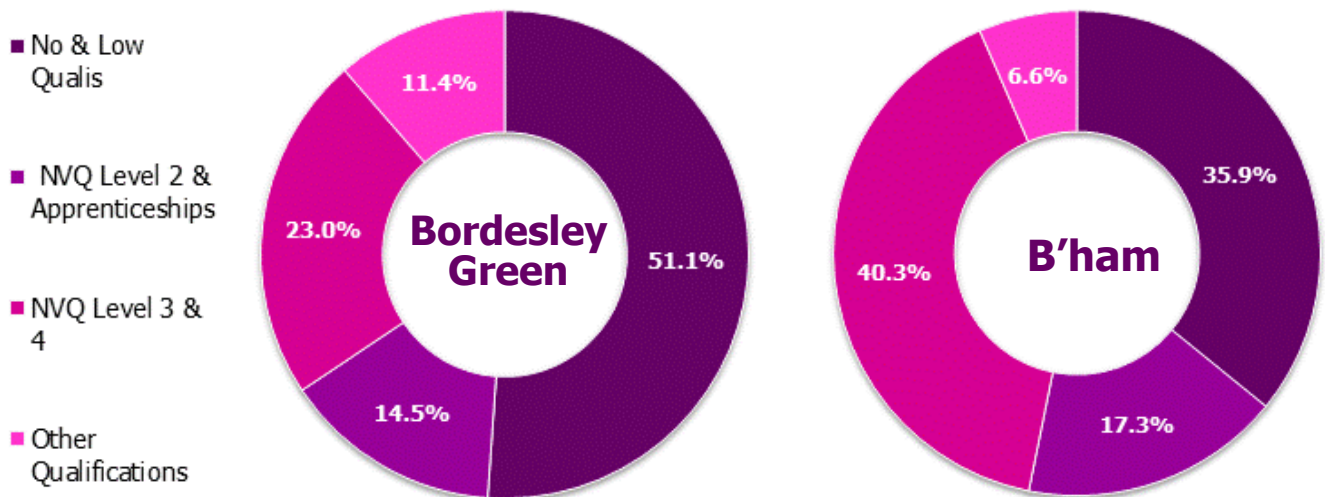
