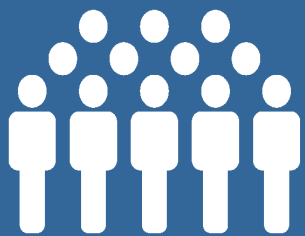

Bordesley & Highgate Ward is an inner city ward located to the south of the city centre. It has a population of 13,242 making it the 34th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and has a higher BAME population share.

Bordesley & Highgate is amongst the more deprived wards in the city and has the 17th lowest average income. Resident employment rates in the ward are lower than the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well above the Birmingham average.

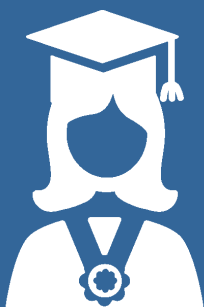

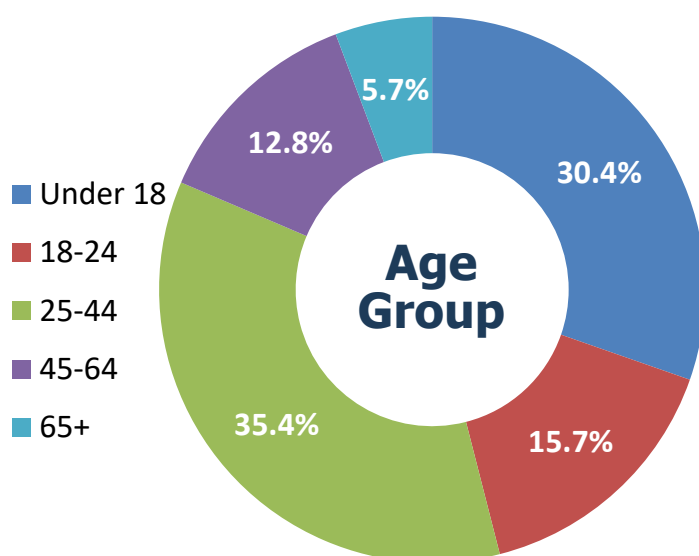

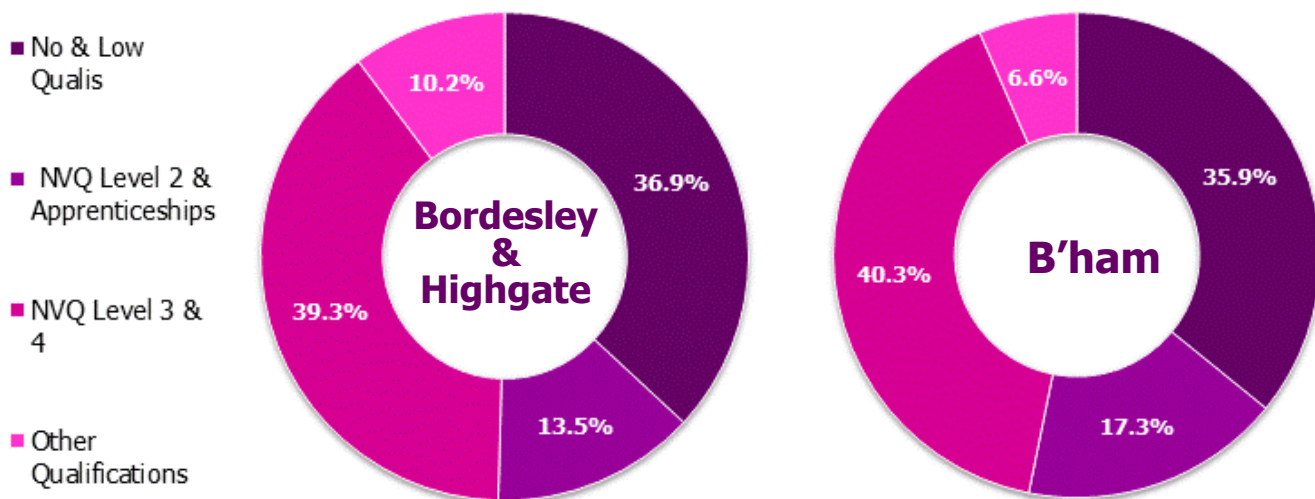
