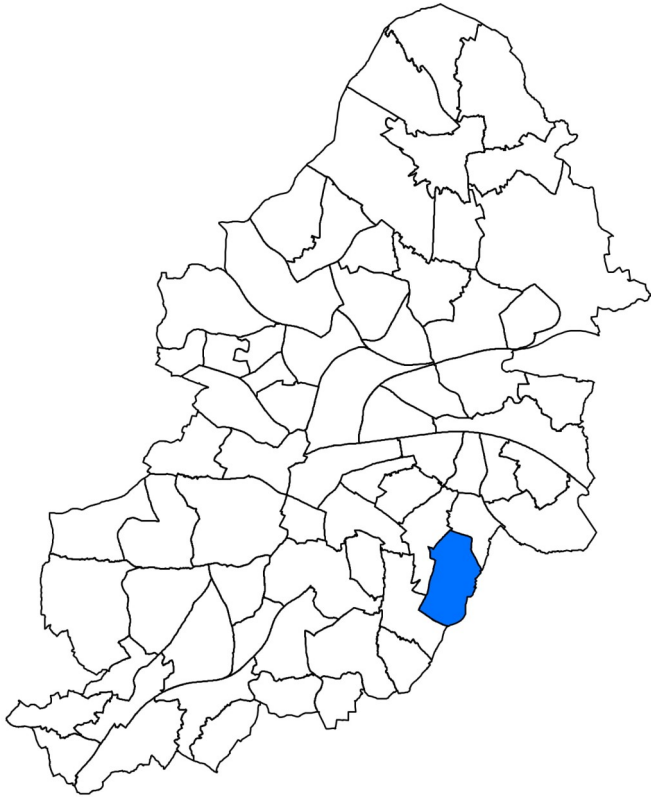


Acocks Green Ward Factsheet

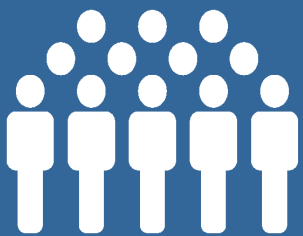


Acocks Green ward is located in the south east of the city. It has a population of 23,117 making it the 3rd most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a similar age profile to the city as a whole and a similar ethnic make up.

Acocks Green is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are slightly lower than the Birmingham average.

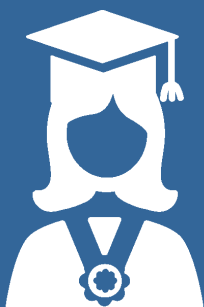

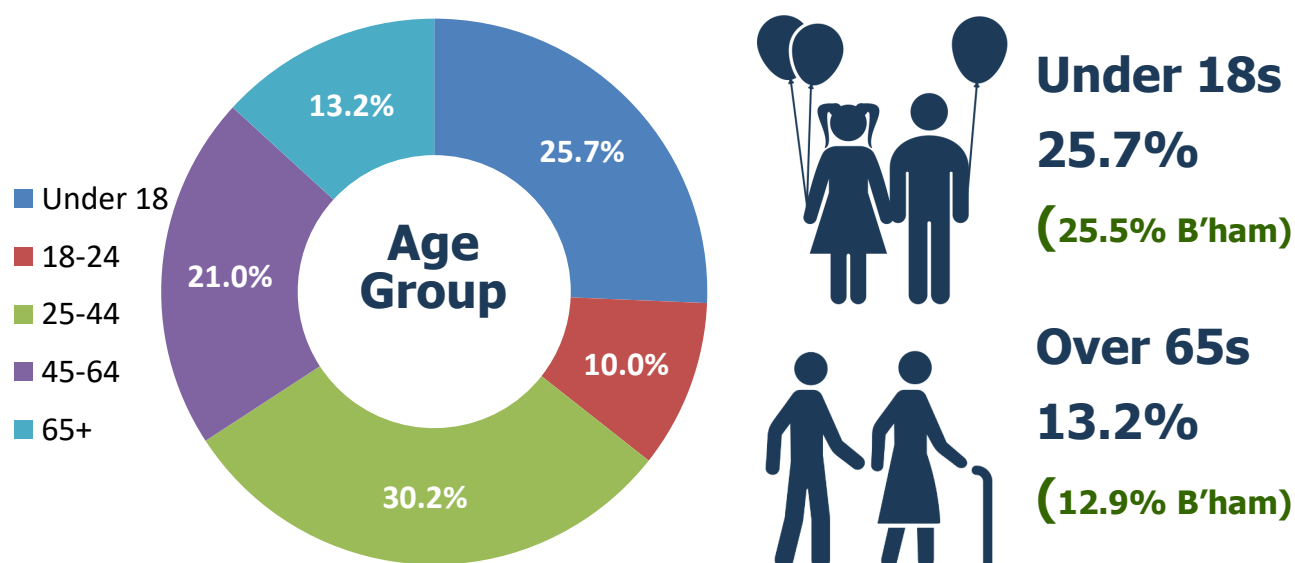

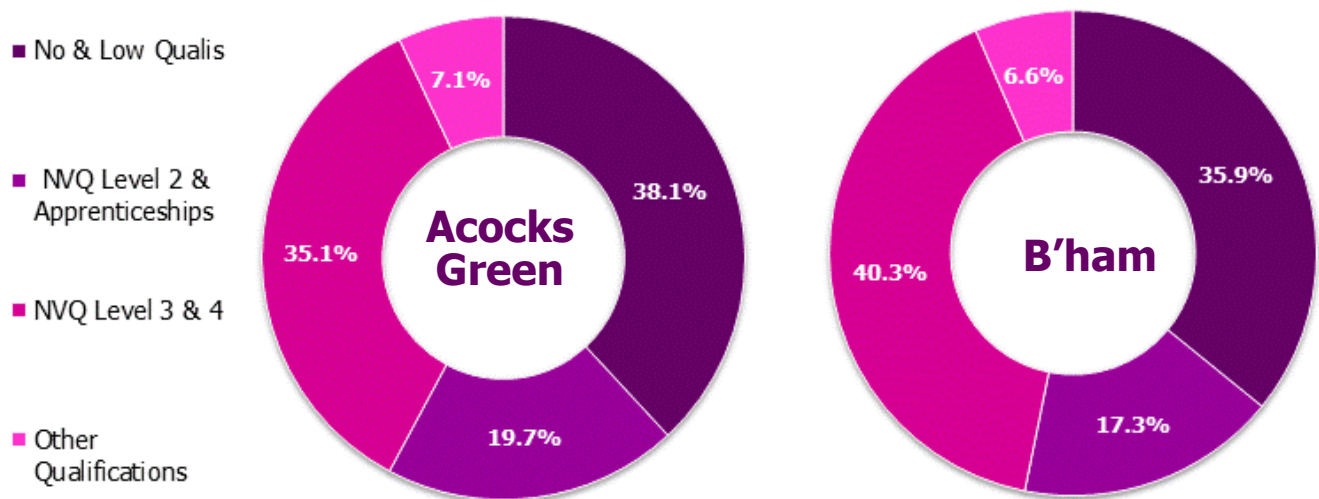
