

# Bromford & Hodge Hill Ward Factsheet



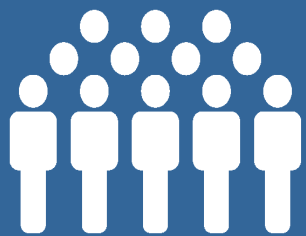
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Bromford & Hodge Hill is a suburban ward located in the east of the city. It has a population of 20,446 making it the 17th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a similar age profile to the city as a whole and a slightly higher BAME population share.

Bromford & Hodge Hill is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are slightly below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are similar to the Birmingham average.

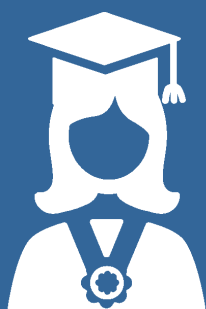

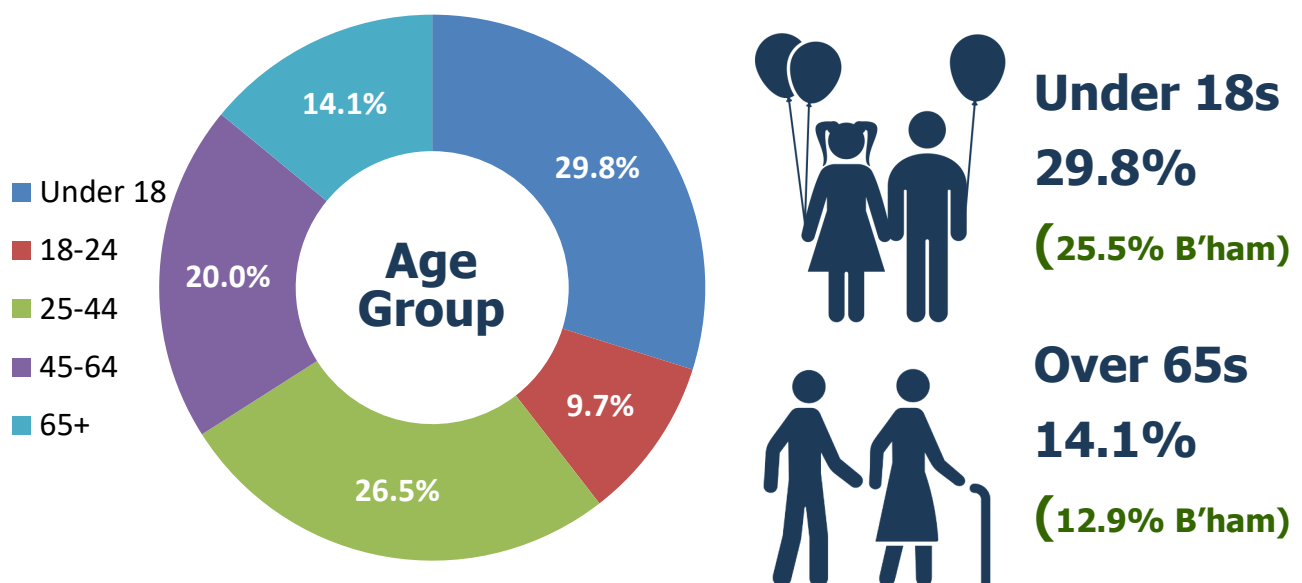

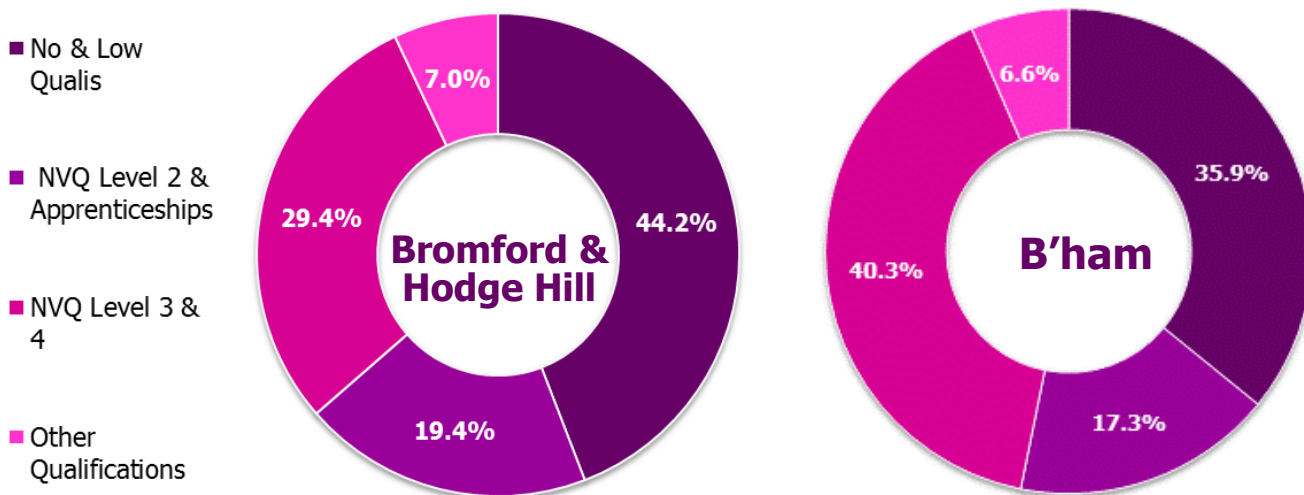
