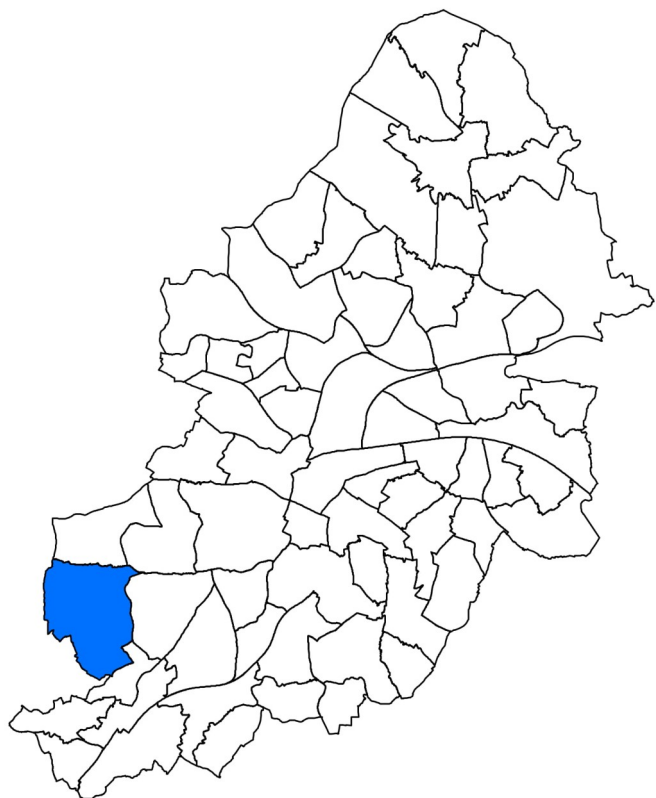


Bartley Green Ward Factsheet



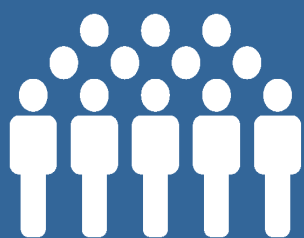

Bartley Green ward is located in the south west of the city. It has a population of 22,014 making it the ninth most populous ward in the city.

The ward has an older age profile than the city as a whole and has a lower BAME population share.

Bartley Green is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are a little above the Birmingham average.

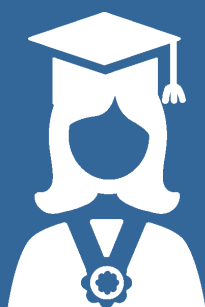

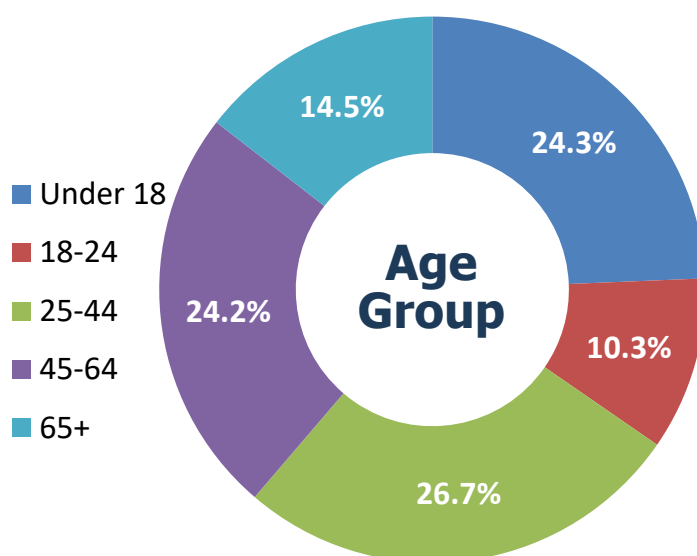

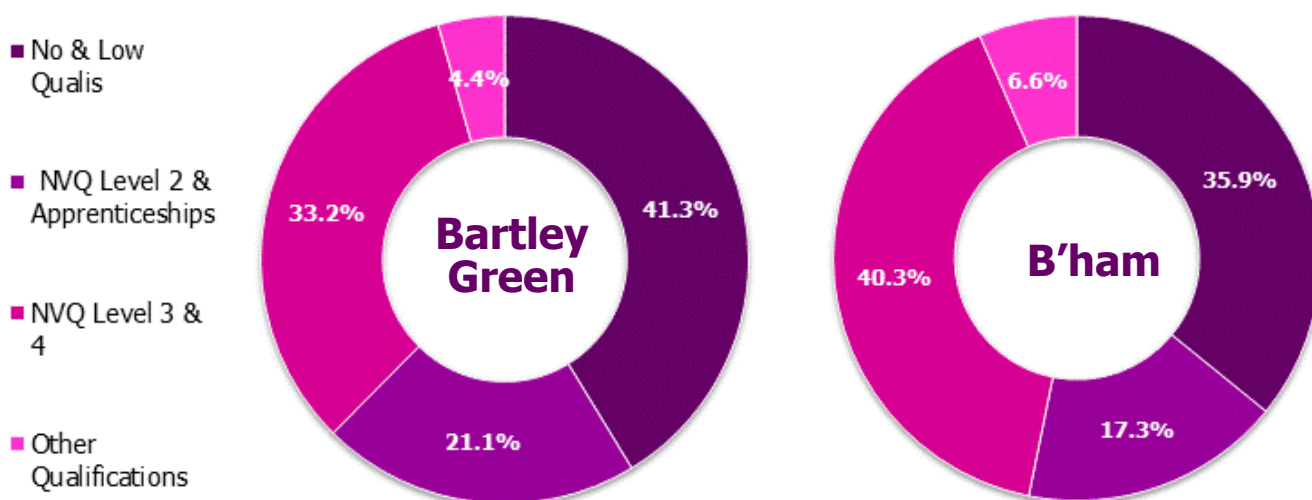
