Bartley Green ward is located in the south west of the city. It has a population of 22,6684 making it the $12^{\rm th}$ most populous ward in the city.

The ward has an older age profile than the city as a whole and has a lower BAME population share.

Bartley Green is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and has the 30th highest share of working age residents with no qualifications out of the city's 69 wards.

Resident employment rates in the ward and claimant count unemployment proportions are similar to the average for Birmingham as a whole.





Child Poverty

Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) data on the number and proportion of children living in low income families provide an indication of the number of children living in poverty in each ward of the city. Low income families are defined as those whose household income is less than 60% of average household income. Only families who have claimed Child Benefit and at least one other household benefit are included in the statistics.

In 2021/22 there were 1,810 children living in low income households in Bartley Green, 29.4% of all children in the ward, meaning the ward is ranked 43rd in the city in terms of the levels of child poverty.



Economic Output

New experimental data from the ONS provides Gross Value Added (GVA) a measure of economic output at LSOA level. Ward economic output has been calculated using an LSOA best fit approach. Total economic output in Bartley Green stood at £275m in 2020 (latest data available) and GVA per head was £12,126. Bartley Green has the 22^{nd} largest ward economy in the city in terms of GVA.
