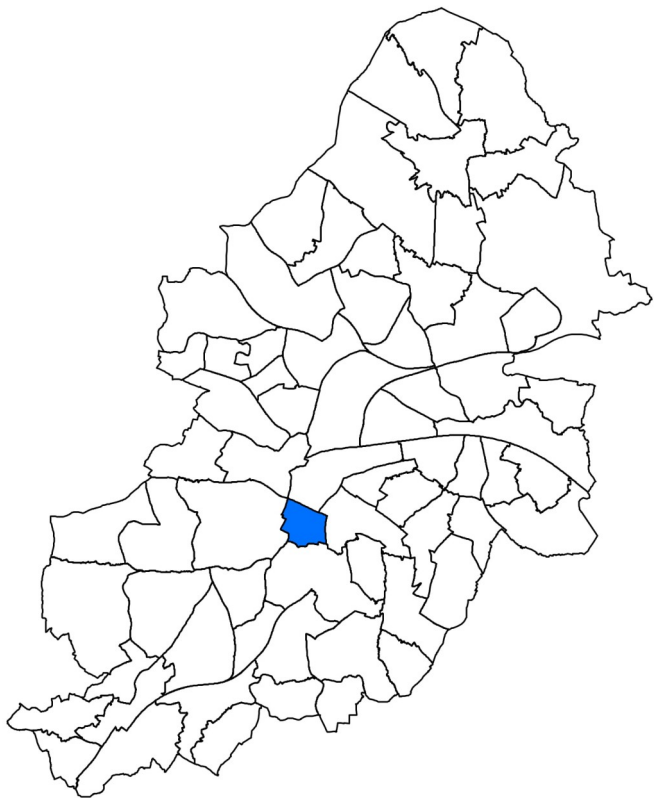


Balsall Heath West Ward Factsheet



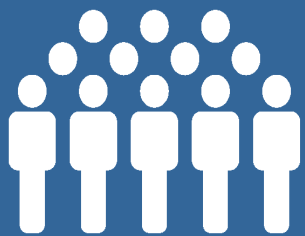

Balsall Heath West ward is located in the inner city to the south of the city centre. It has a population of 11,165 making it the 49th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and has a higher BAME population share.

Balsall Heath West is amongst the city's most deprived wards and has the 16th lowest average income out of the city's 69 wards.

Resident employment rates in the ward are well below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well above the Birmingham average.

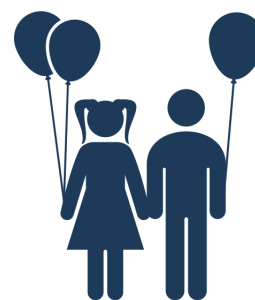
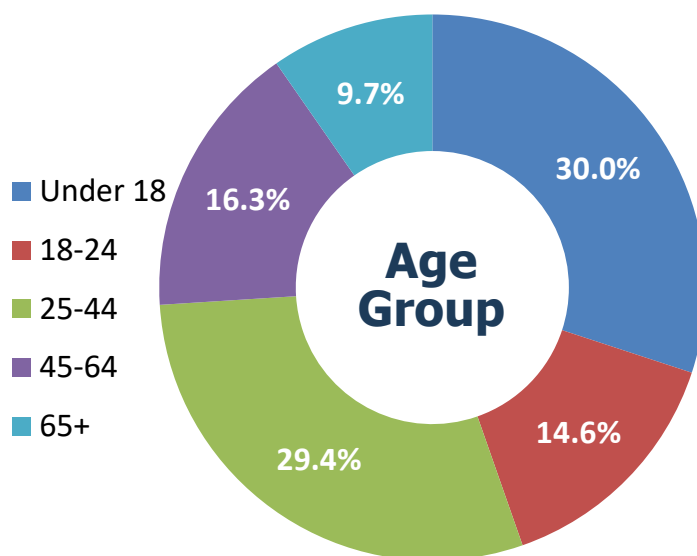

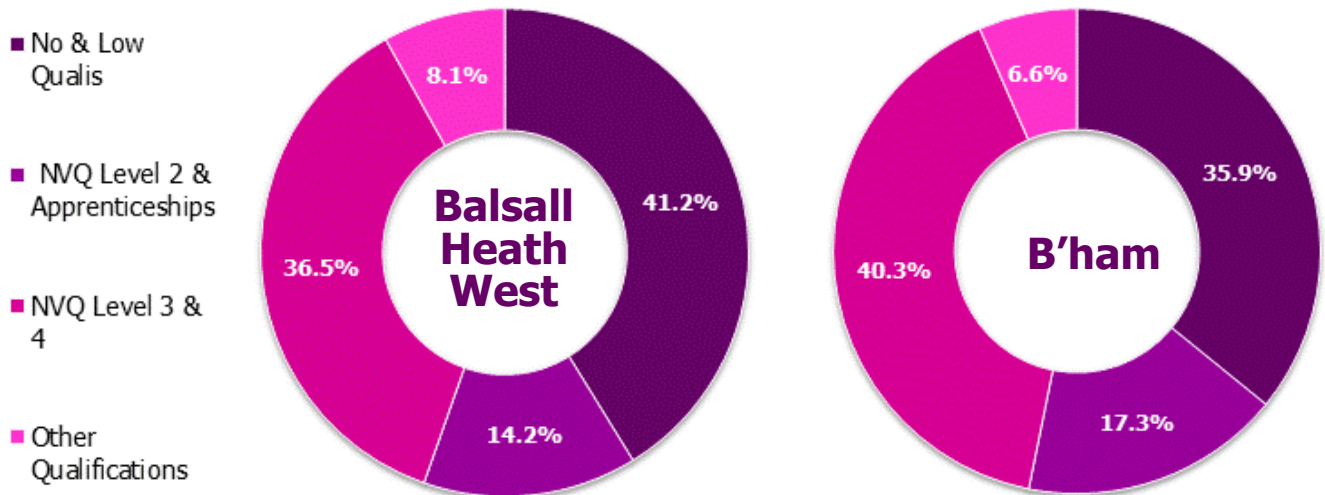
