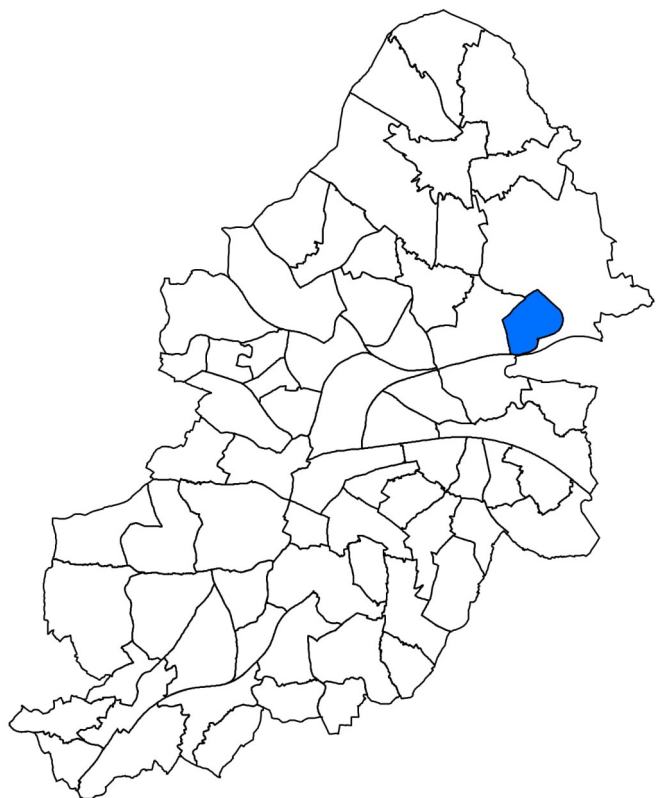


# Castle Vale Ward Factsheet



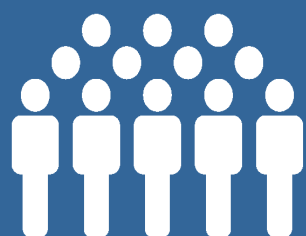
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Castle Vale is an outer city ward located in the east of the city. It has a population of 9,971 making it the 60th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a slightly older age profile than the city as a whole and a lower BAME population share.

Castle Vale is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are slightly below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are similar to the Birmingham average.

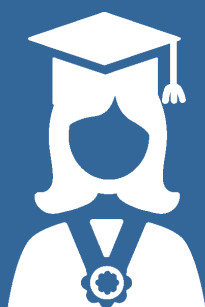

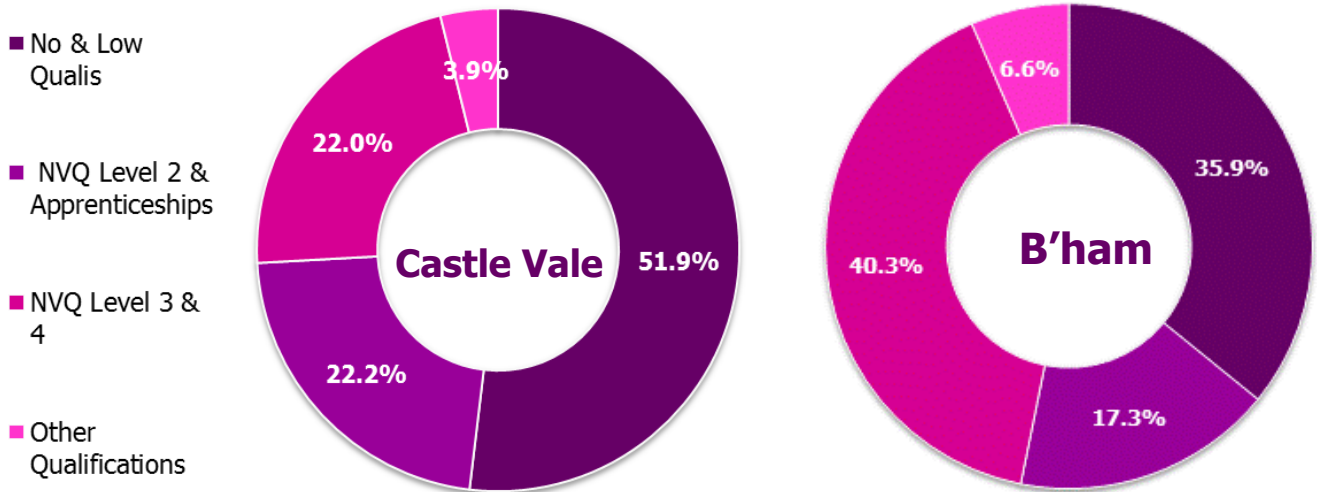
