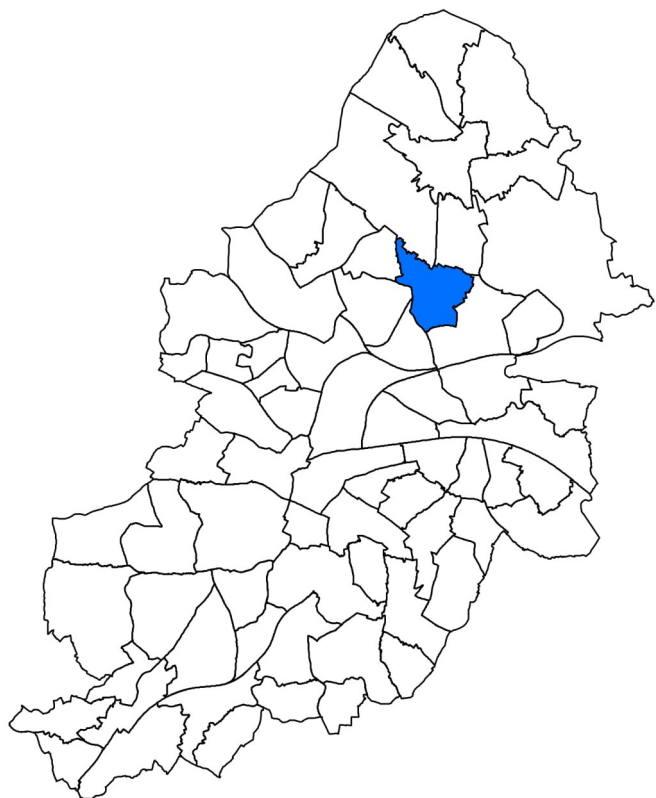


# Erdington Ward Factsheet



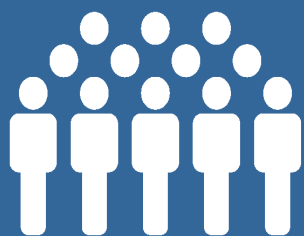
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Erdington is a suburban ward located in the north of the city. It has a population of 18,603 making it the 29th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a slightly older age profile than the city as a whole and a lower BAME population share.

Erdington is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are similar to the Birmingham average.

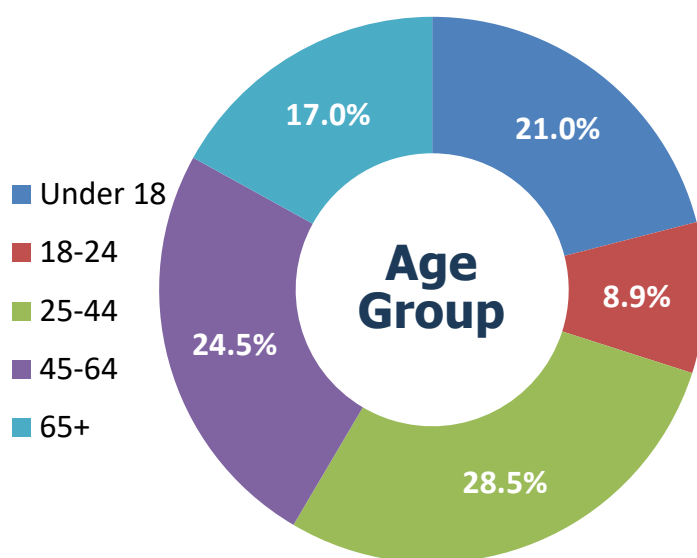

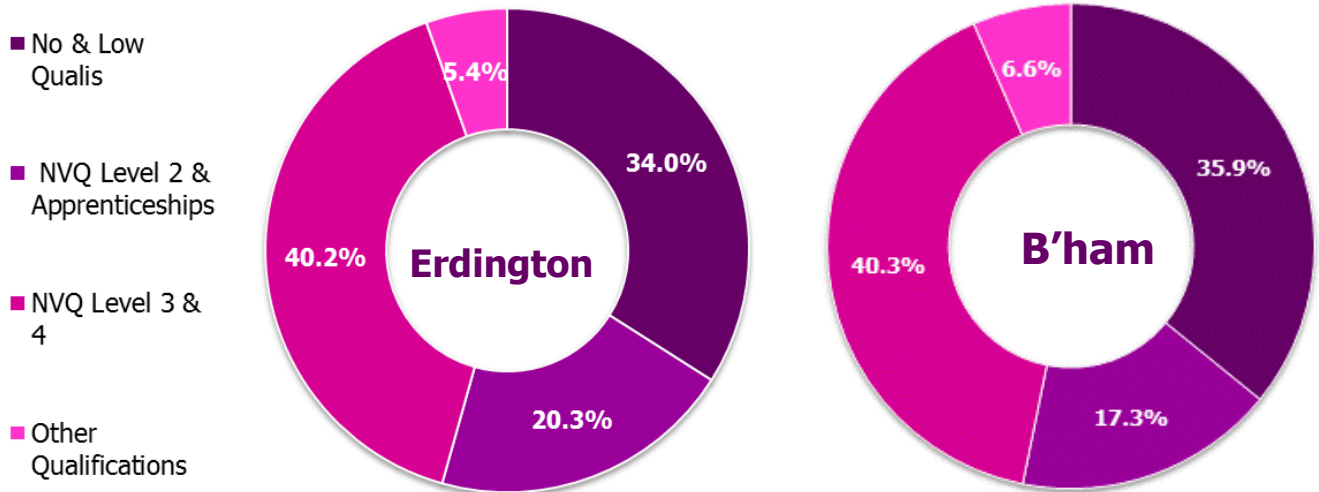
