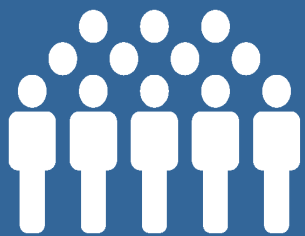

Lozells Ward is an inner city ward located to the north west of the city centre. It has a population of 9,153 making it the city's 3rd smallest ward in terms of population.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and has a higher BAME population share.

Lozells is one of the most deprived wards in the city and has the 8th lowest average income out of the 69 wards in the city.

Resident employment rates in the ward are much lower than the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well above the Birmingham average.

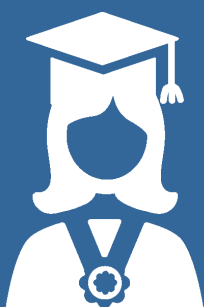

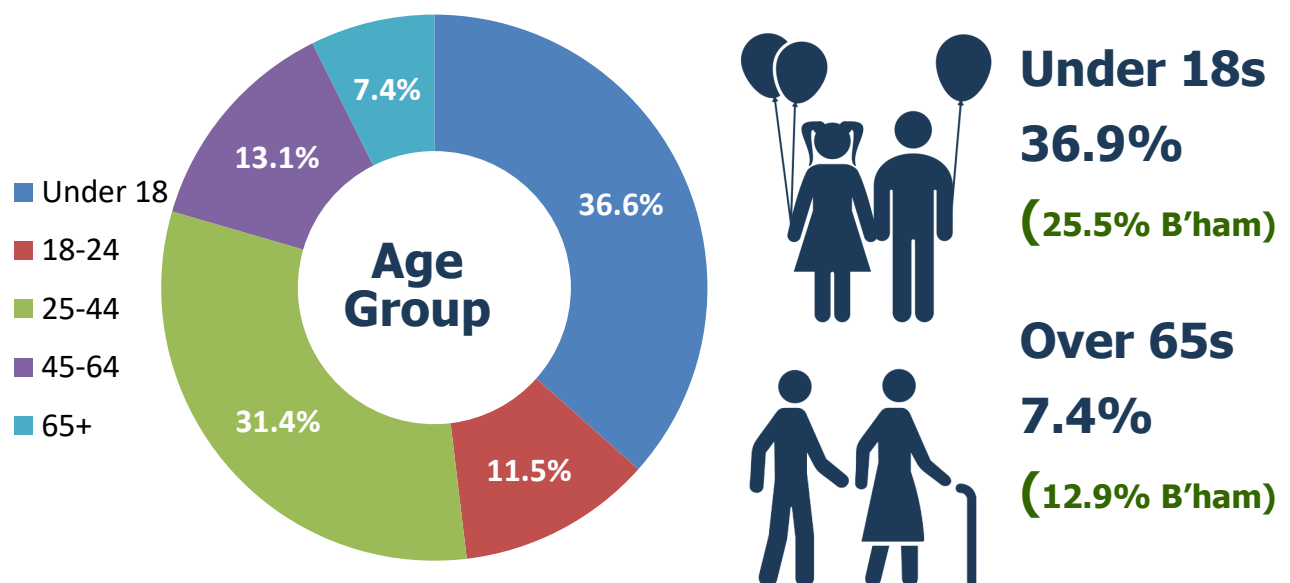

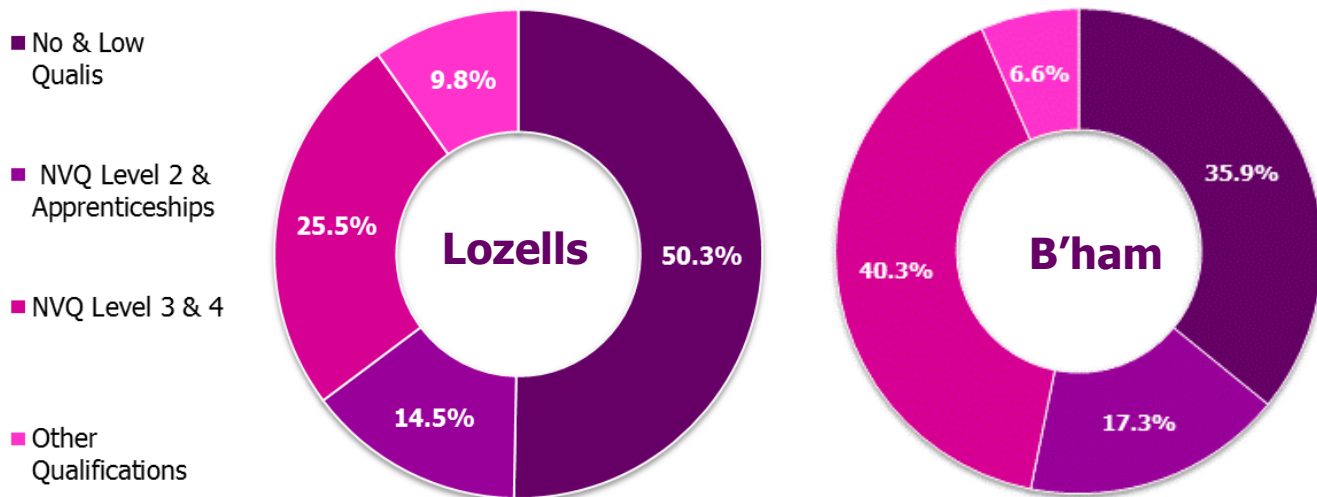
