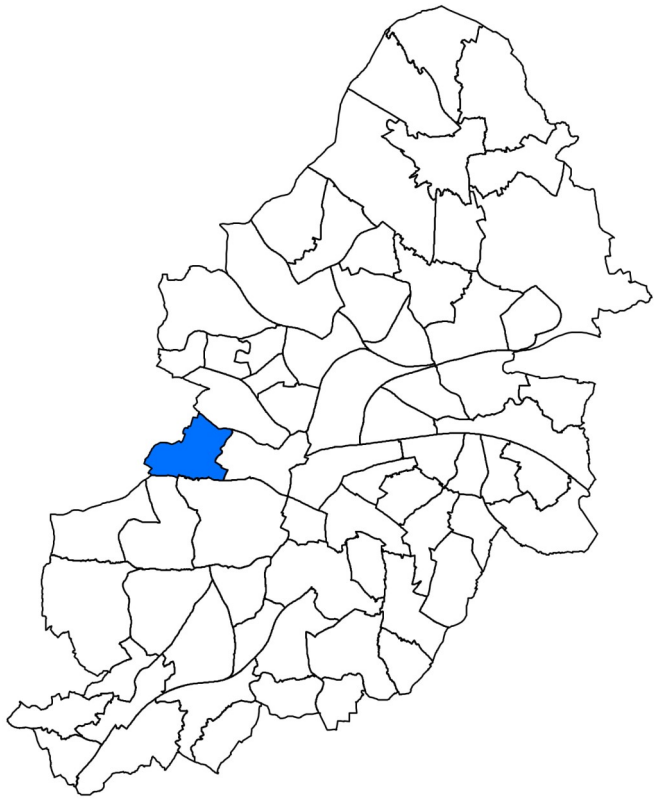


North Edgbaston Ward Factsheet



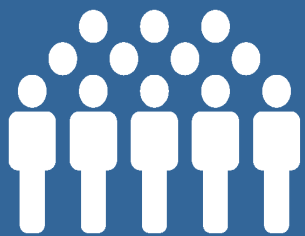
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North Edgbaston Ward is located in the west of the city. It has a population of 21,934 making it the 10th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and a smaller BAME share of the population.

North Edgbaston is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are just below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are above the Birmingham average.

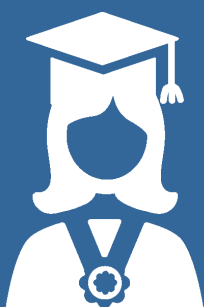

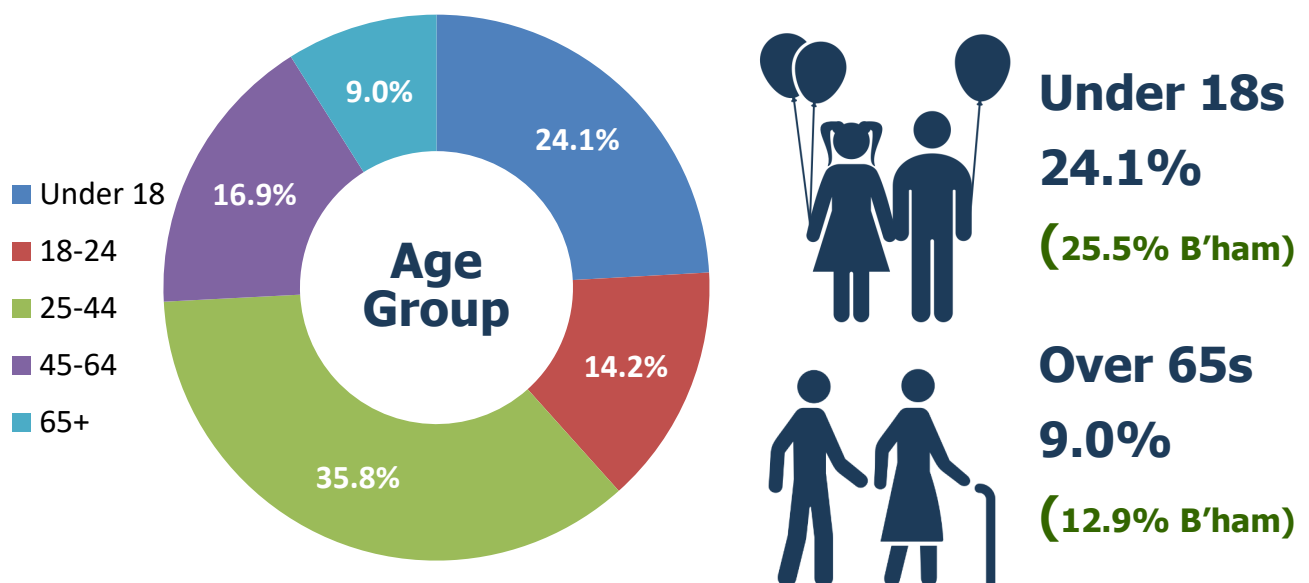

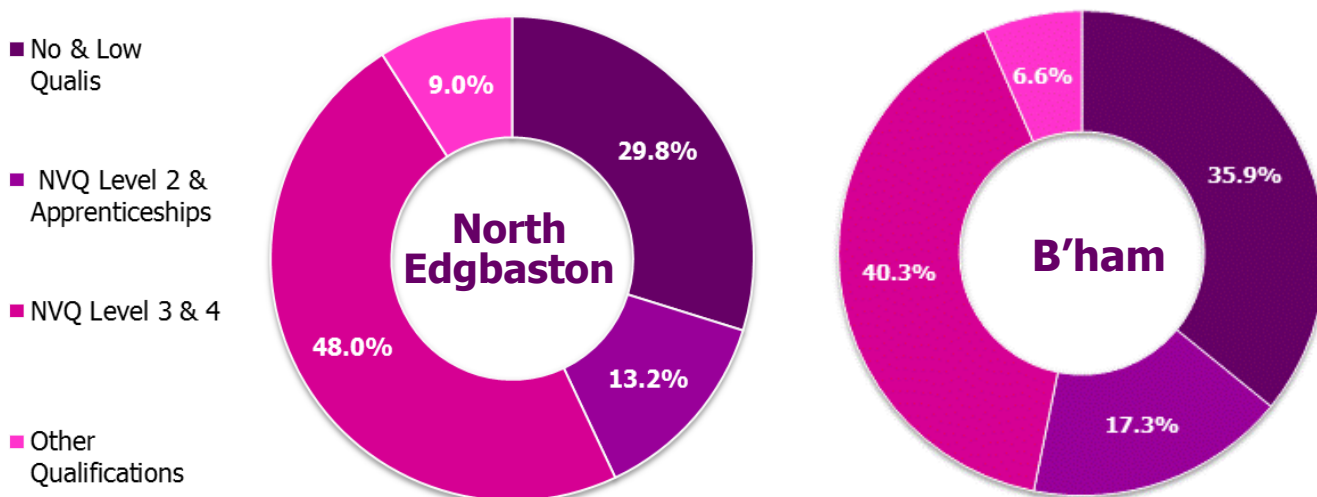
