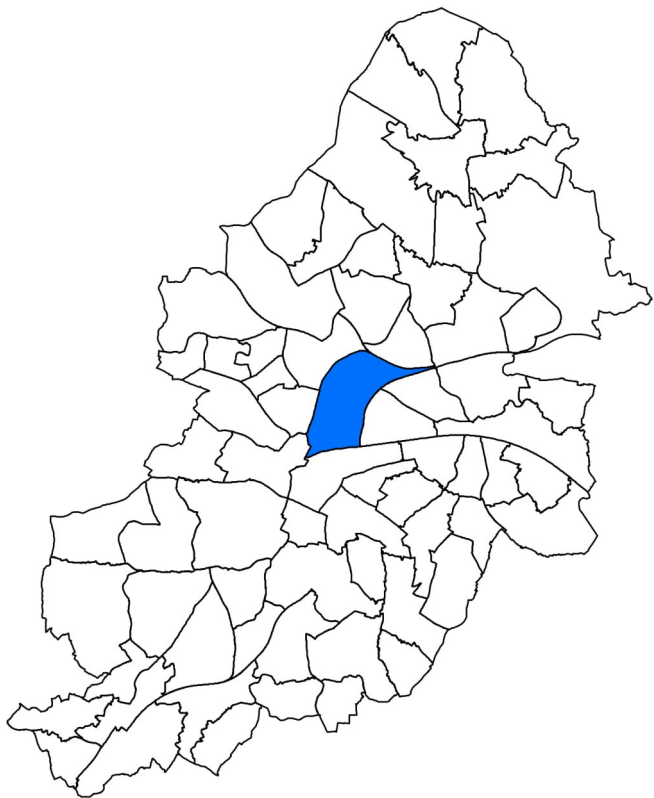


Nechells Ward Factsheet

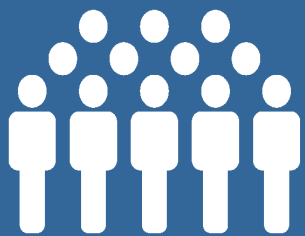

Nechells Ward is located in the inner city and contains part of the city centre. It has a population of 13,980 making it the 33rd most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a significantly younger age profile than the city as a whole and has a higher BAME population share.

Nechells is amongst the city's most deprived wards and has the lowest average income out of the city's 69 wards. Resident employment rates in the ward are well below the city average and economically inactive residents (those not in work or seeking work) account for nearly half of working age residents.

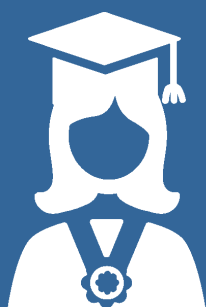

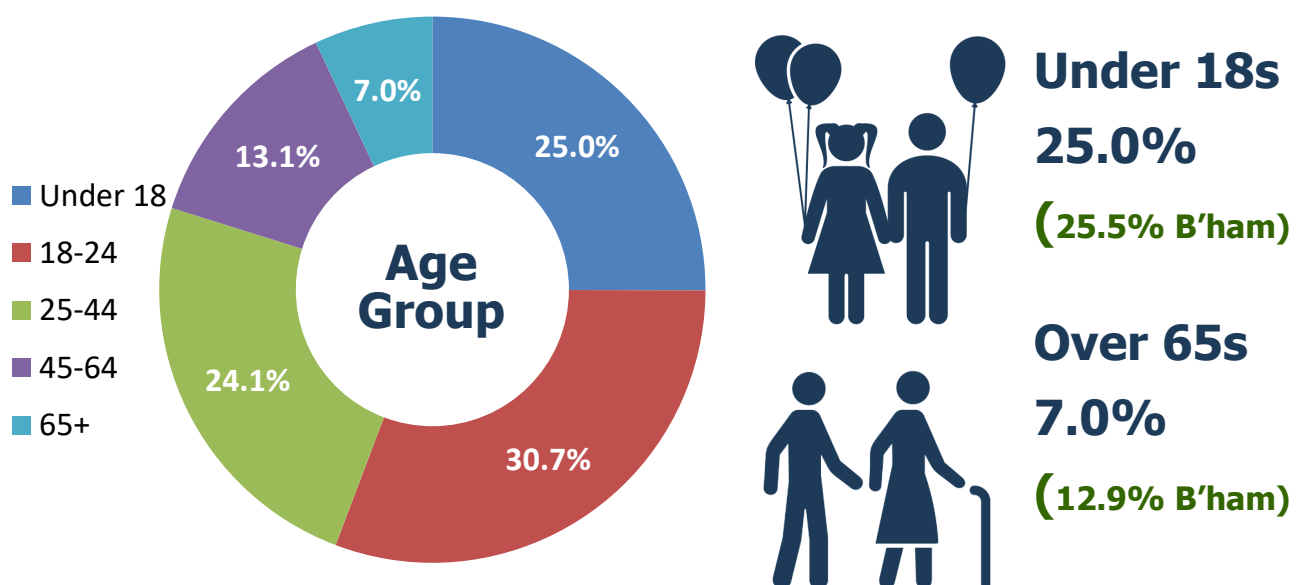

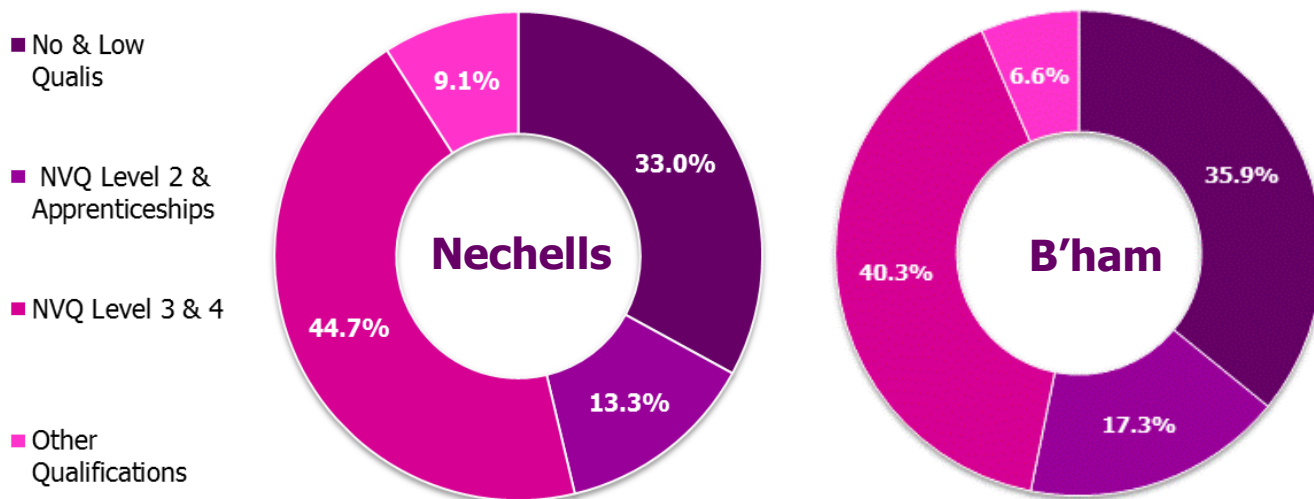
