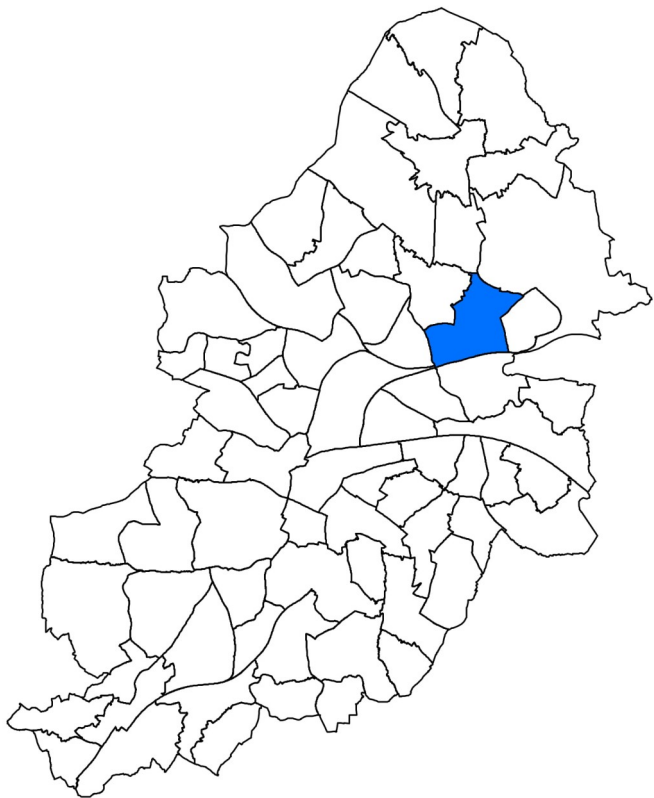


Pype Hayes Ward Factsheet



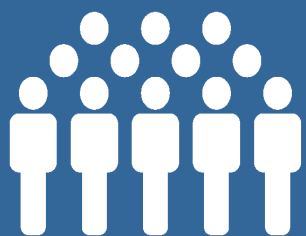

Pype Hayes is a suburban ward located in the north east of the city. It has a population of 10,701 making it the 54th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a slightly older age profile than the city as a whole and a higher BAME population share.

Pype Hayes is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation and average income.

Resident employment rates in the ward are above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are below the Birmingham average.

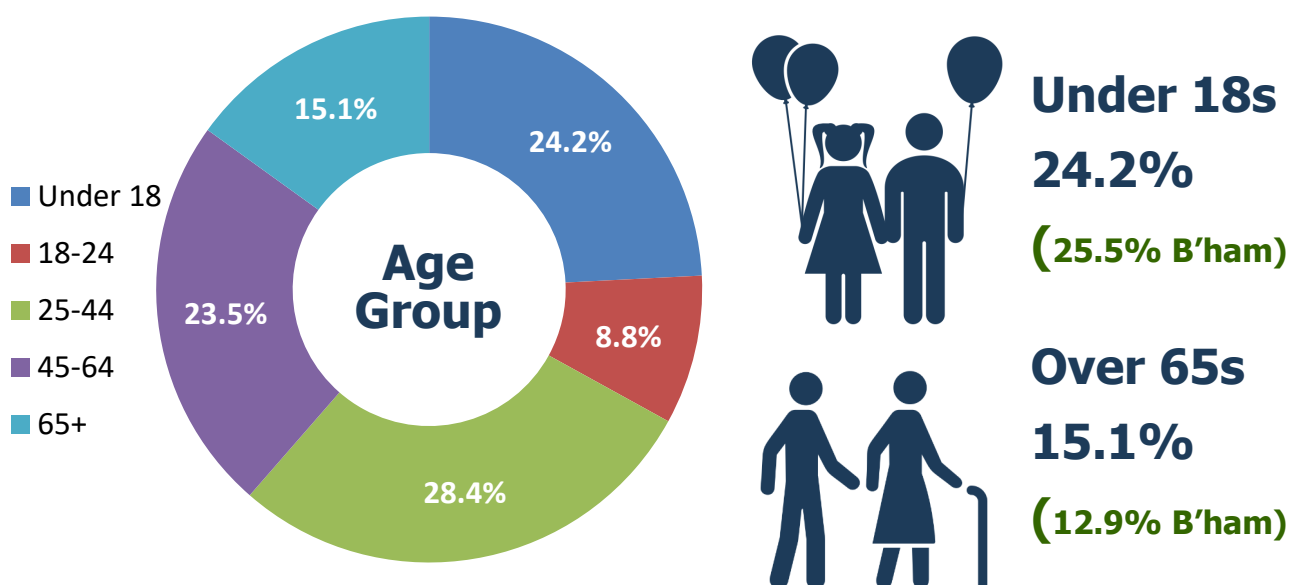

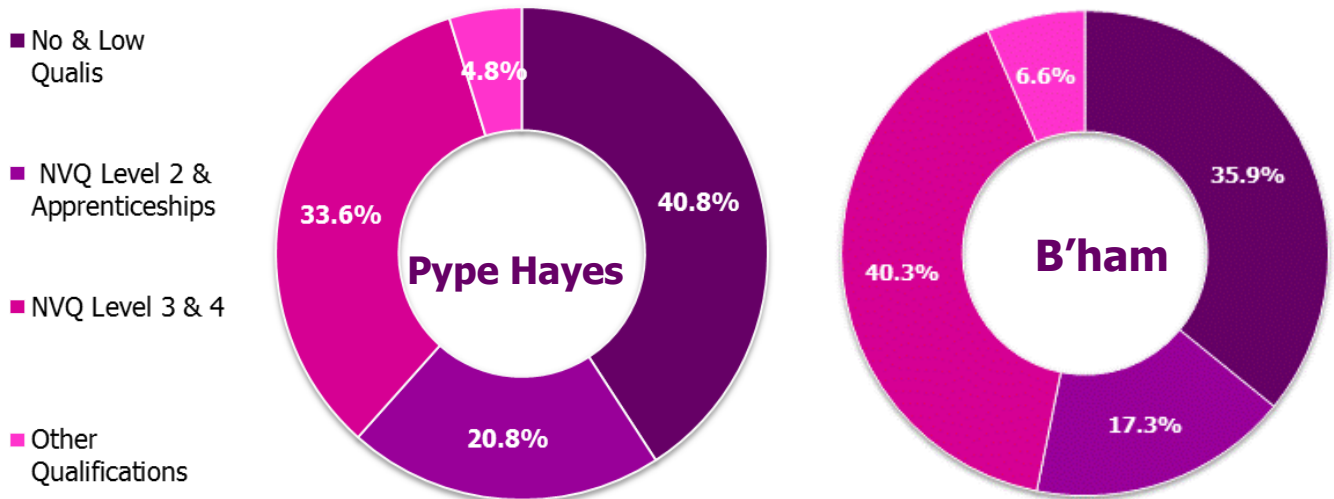
