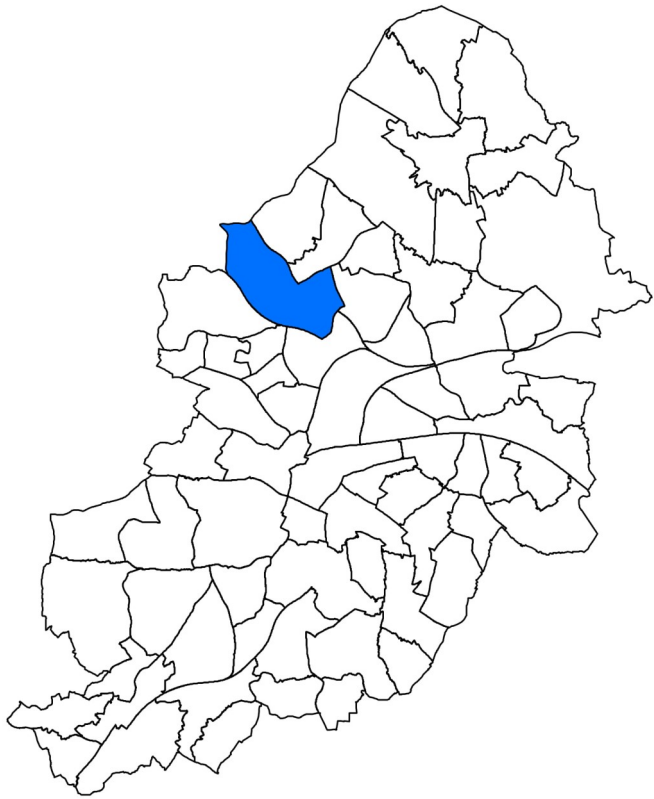


# Perry Barr Ward Factsheet



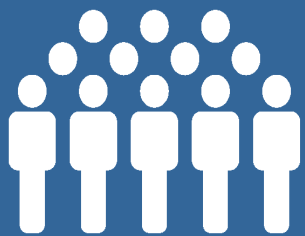

Perry Barr is a suburban ward located in the north west of the city. It has a population of 20,566 making it the 16th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a slightly older age profile than the city as a whole and a slightly higher BAME population share.

Perry Barr is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for average income but is one of the least deprived wards in the city.

Resident employment rates in the ward are above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are below the Birmingham average.

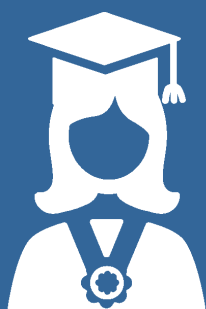

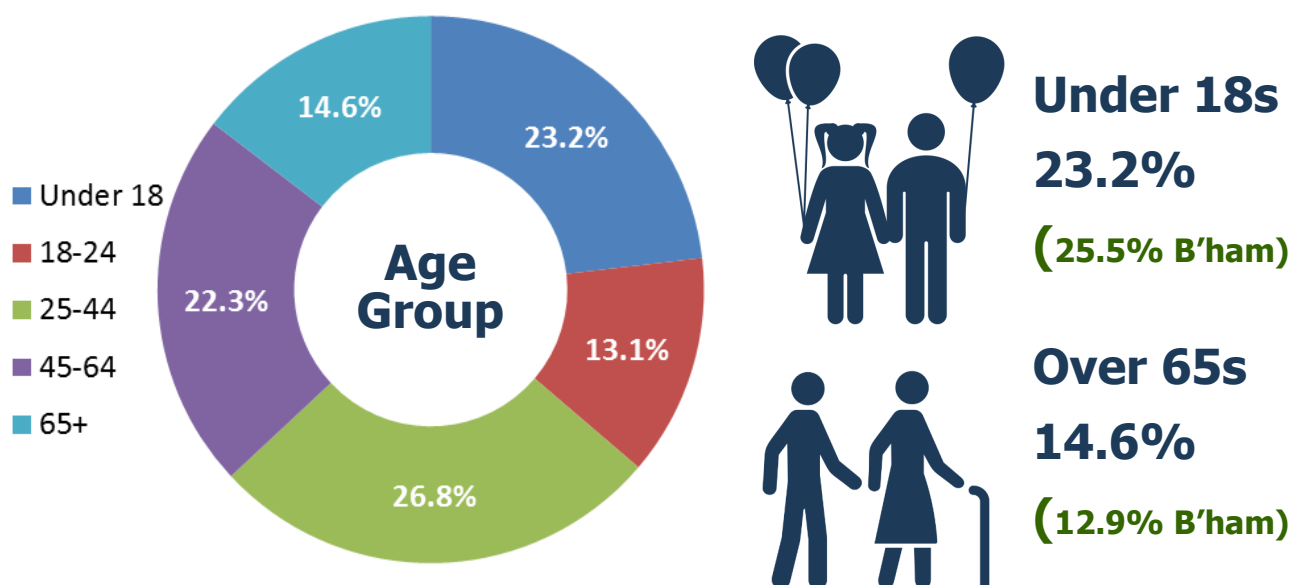

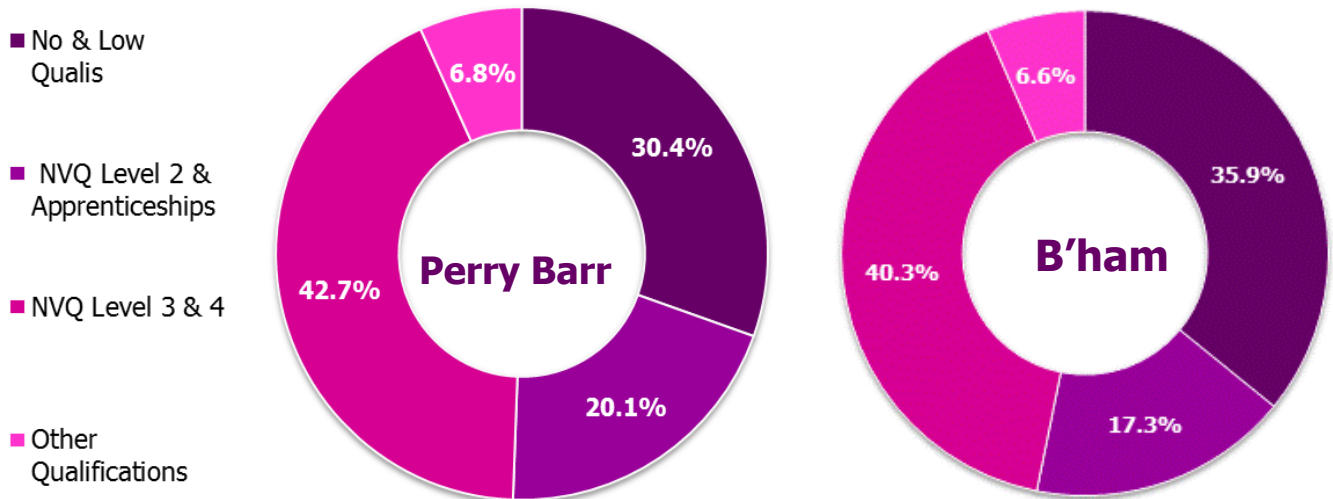
