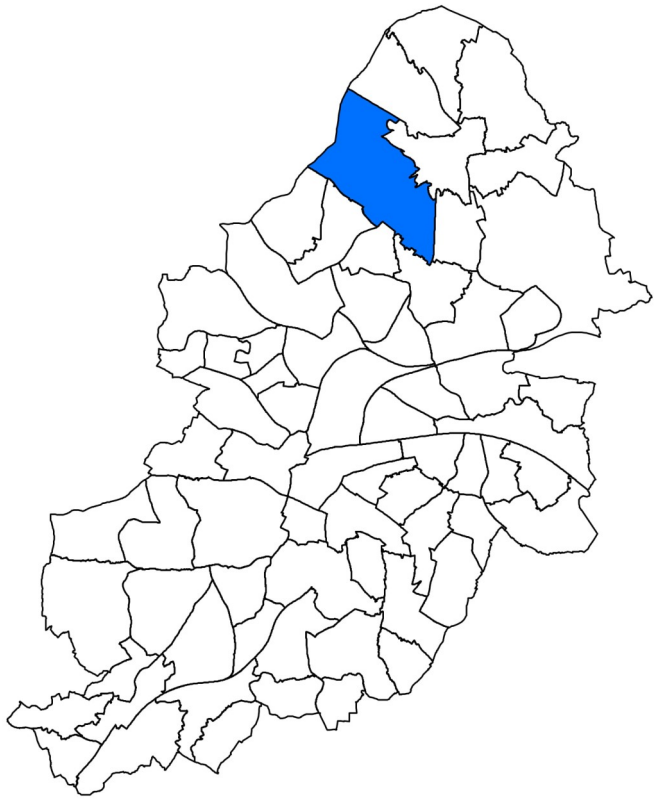


Sutton Vesey Ward Factsheet



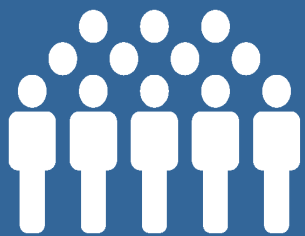

Sutton Vesey is a suburban ward located in the north of the city. It has a population of 19,695 making it the 25th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has an older age profile than the city as a whole and a lower BAME population share.

Sutton Vesey is one of the least deprived wards in the city and has the 7th highest average income levels out of the 69 Birmingham wards.

Resident employment rates in the ward are well above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well below the Birmingham average.

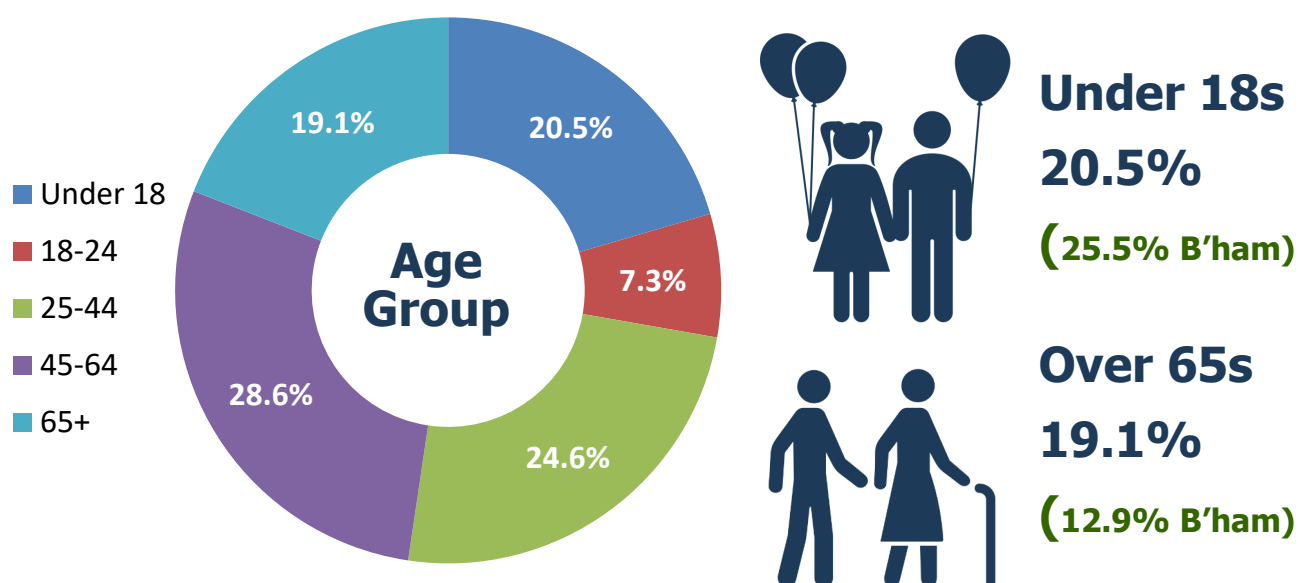

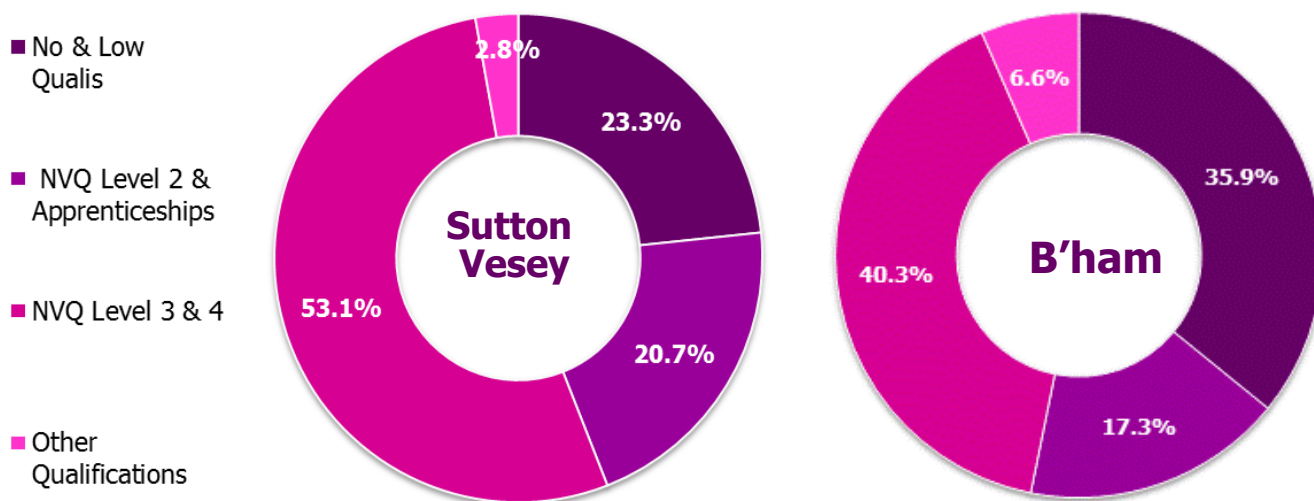
