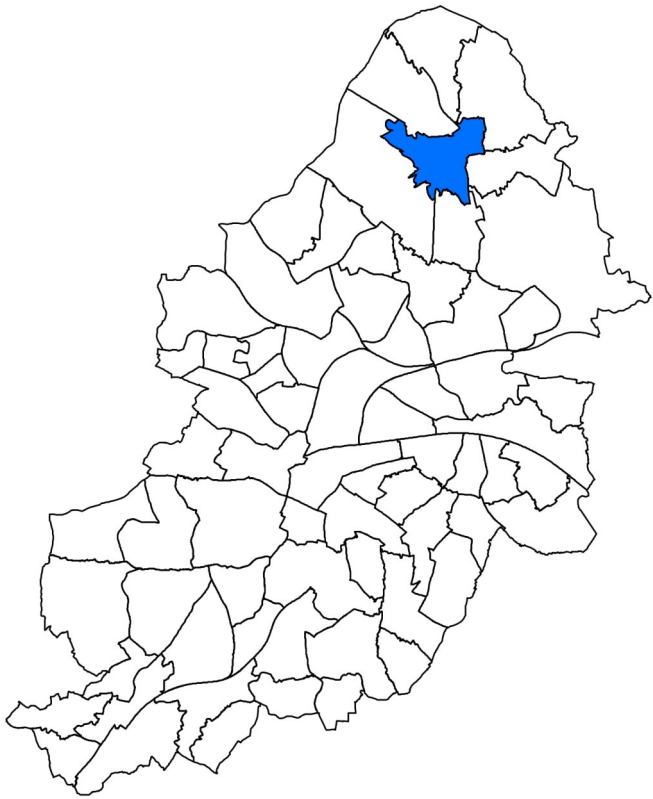


# Sutton Trinity Ward Factsheet



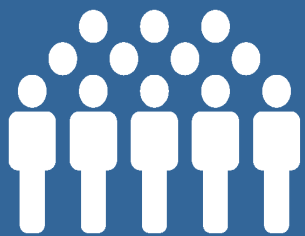

Sutton Trinity is a suburban ward located in the north of the city. It has a population of 8,967 making it the smallest ward in the city in terms of population size.

The ward has an older age profile than the city as a whole and a lower BAME population share.

Sutton Trinity is one of the least deprived wards in the city and has the 4th highest average income levels out of the 69 Birmingham wards.

Resident employment rates in the ward are well above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are well below the Birmingham average.

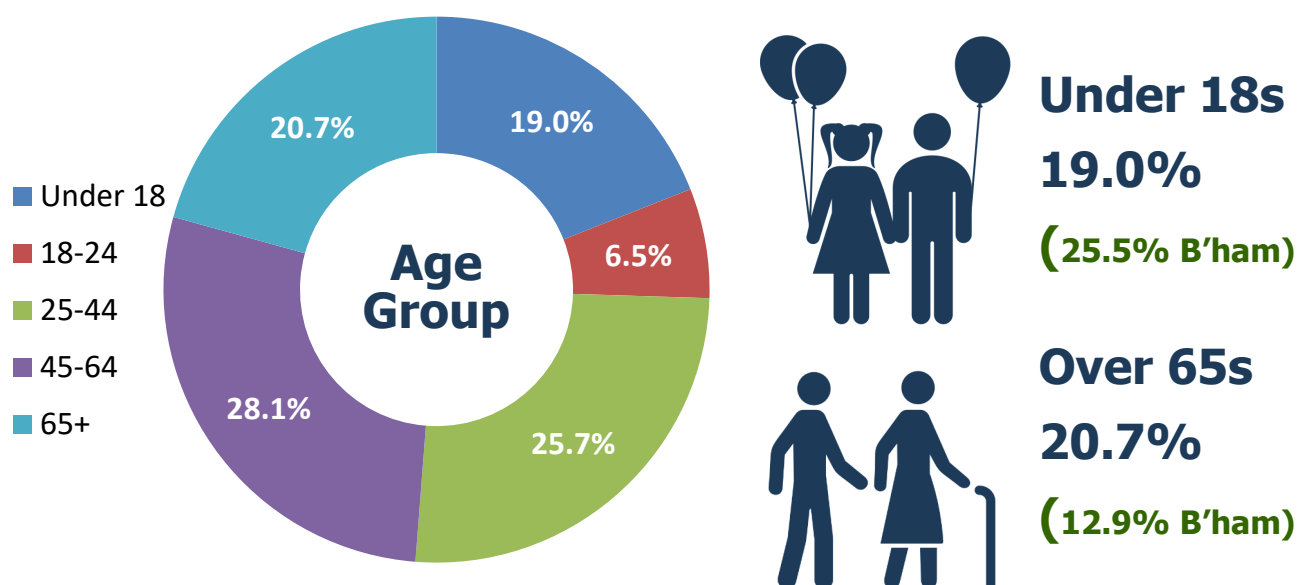

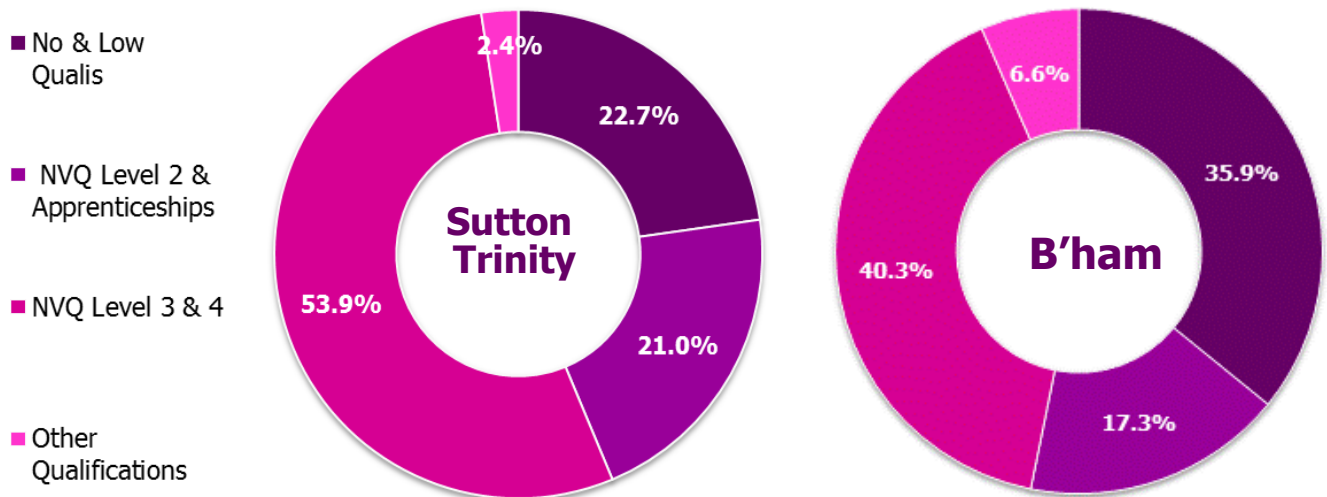
