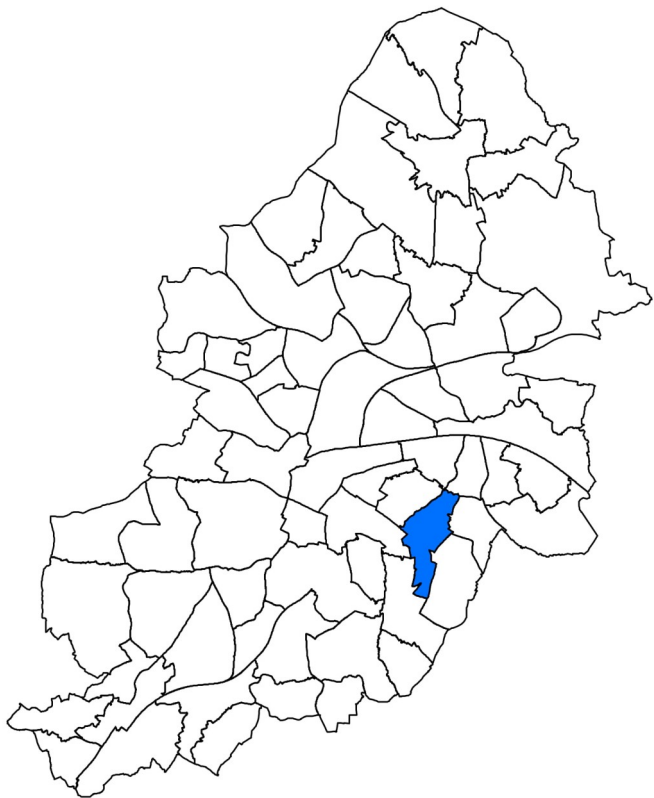


# Tyseley & Hay Mills Ward Factsheet



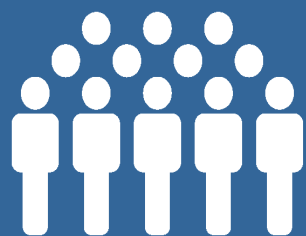
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Tyseley & Hay Mills is a suburban ward located in the east of the city. It has a population of 11,295 making it the 47th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a younger age profile than the city as a whole and a higher BAME population share.

Tyseley & Hay Mills is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels but average income levels are below the city average.

Resident employment rates in the ward are below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are above the Birmingham average.

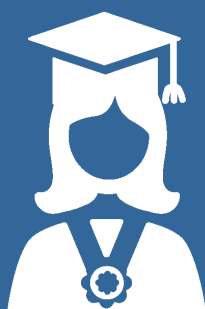

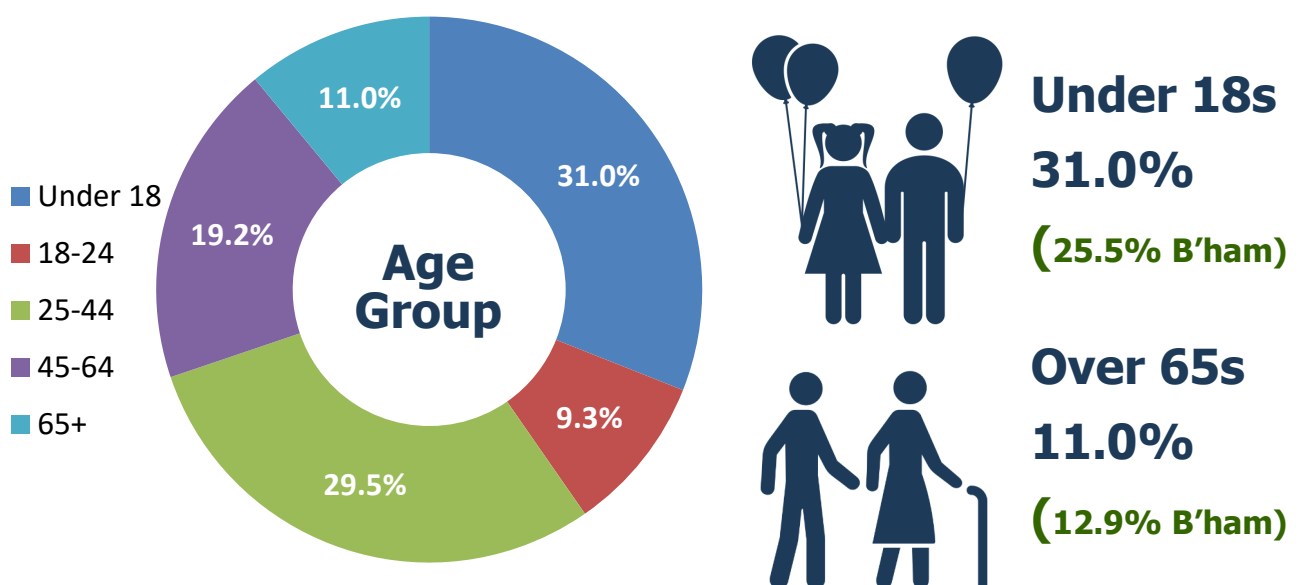

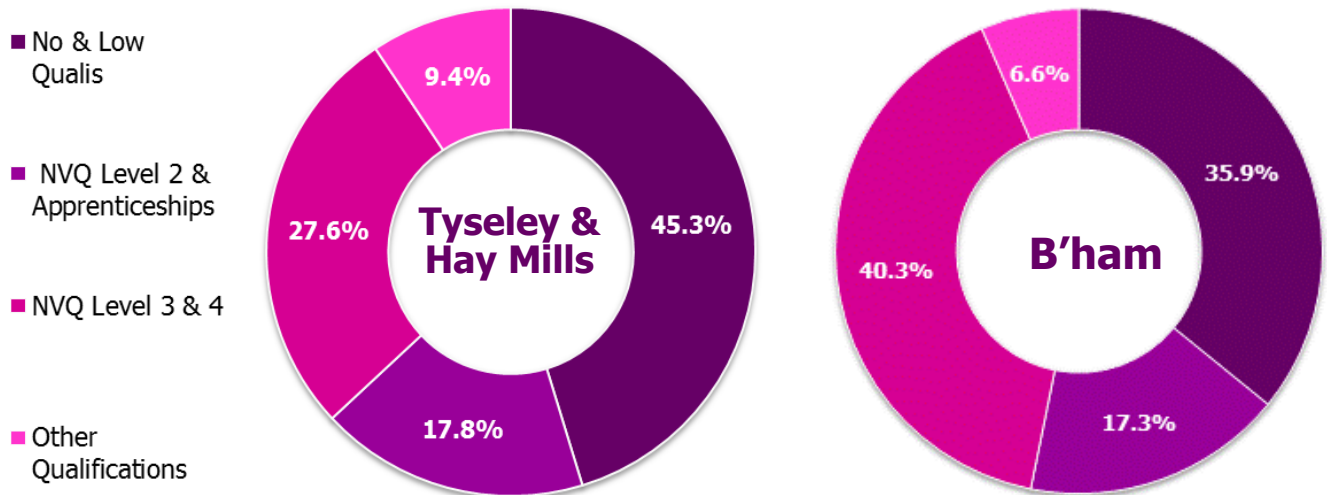
