

# Yardley West & Stechford Ward Factsheet



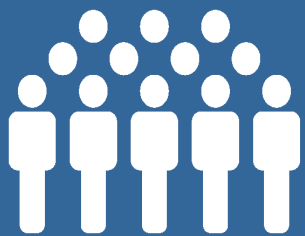
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Yardley West & Stechford is located in the east of the city. It has a population of 11,936 making it the 38th most populous ward in the city.

The ward has a higher proportion of under 18s than the city as a whole and a higher BAME population share.

Yardley West & Stechford is mid ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation but towards the lower end for average income levels.

Resident employment rates in the ward are below the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are above the Birmingham average.

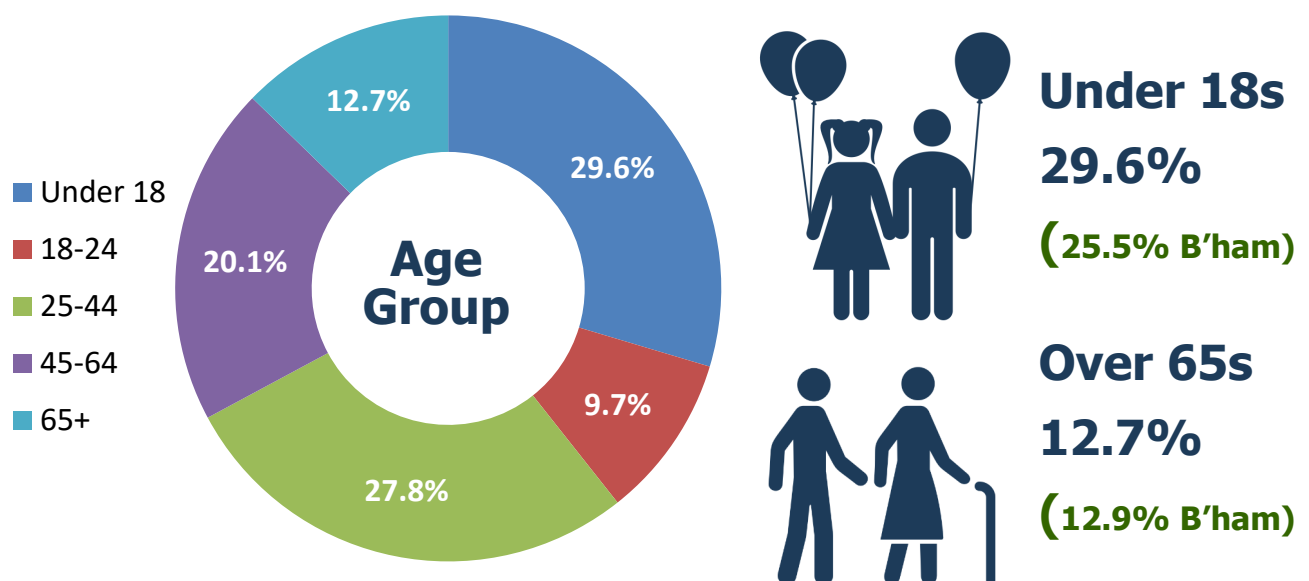

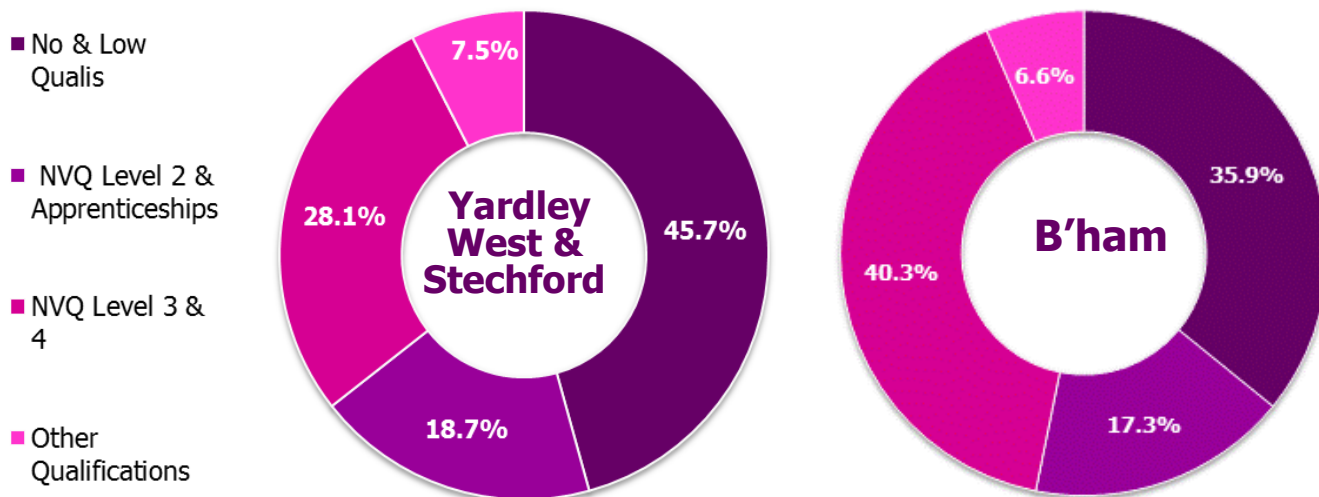
