### **Yardley East Ward Factsheet**



Yardley East is an outer city ward located in the east of the city. It has a population of 11,048 making it the 56<sup>th</sup> most populous ward in the city.

The ward has an older age profile than the city as a whole and a lower BAME population share.

Yardley East is mid to low ranking amongst the city's 69 wards for deprivation levels.

Resident employment rates in the ward are well above the city average and claimant count unemployment proportions are below the Birmingham average.





#### **Child Poverty**

Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) data on the number and proportion of children living in low income families provide an indication of the number of children living in poverty in each ward of the city. Low income families are defined as those whose household income is less than 60% of average household income. Only families who have claimed Child Benefit and at least one other household benefit are included in the statistics.

In 2021/22 there were 986 children living in low income households in Yardley East, 34.8% of all children in the ward, meaning the ward is ranked 28<sup>th</sup> in the city in terms of the levels of child poverty.

#### **Economic Output**

New experimental data from the ONS provides Gross Value Added (GVA) a measure of economic output at LSOA level. Ward economic output has been calculated using an LSOA best fit approach. Total economic output in Yardley East stood at £44m in 2020 (latest data available) and GVA per head was £4,305. Yardley East has the smallest ward economy in the city in terms of GVA.
