To minimise the need for estimations and to ensure correct billing, please submit your meter reads regularly.

#### When should I send my meter reads?

Meter reads can be submitted at any time, but for accurate billing please submit:

Electricity meter reads: between 20th and 28th of each month Gas meter reads: from 25th to the last day of each month

#### How do I give you my meter reads?

- 1 The easiest way to submit meter reads is online by clicking here.
- 2 You can also do this by calling our Customer Care Team on 0333 003 7874, selecting option 3, then option 1 for gas / option 2 for electricity.
- 3 Alternatively, email your meter reads to GP.redhill.WME.BirminghamCity@totalgp.com along with your MPAN/MPR and account number.
