Dual Funding 2021/22

Applications required by 7th June 2021

The Dual Funding Programme for 2021/22 launched on 30th April 2021. The application is open to Community, Foundation and Voluntary Controlled Schools (other school types are funded through different routes).

This is an opportunity for schools to apply for assistance with addressing key building priorities. The project must address a condition priority that if not addressed has the potential to lead to full or partial school closure.

The funding will be for new projects which have not yet started, and schools are expected to meet at least 50% of the total project cost.

The deadline date has been set to ensure there is enough time for applications to be assessed. Schools will then be notified and requested to submit Landlord Approval to ensure required works can be programmed in for the summer break.

Flexibility will be provided to ensure the school estate remains supported. If additional time is required, please contact us.

No works should commence until Landlord Approval has been granted. **If you are planning for works to be carried out in the summer, we need to receive your Landlord Approval request by 18**th **June 2021.**
