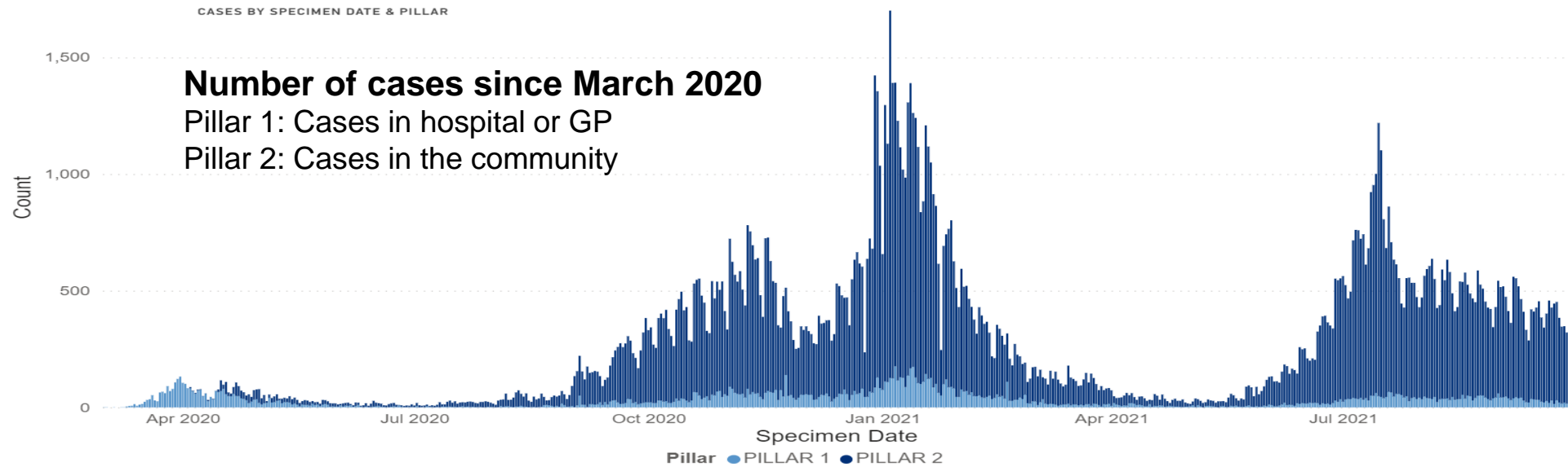
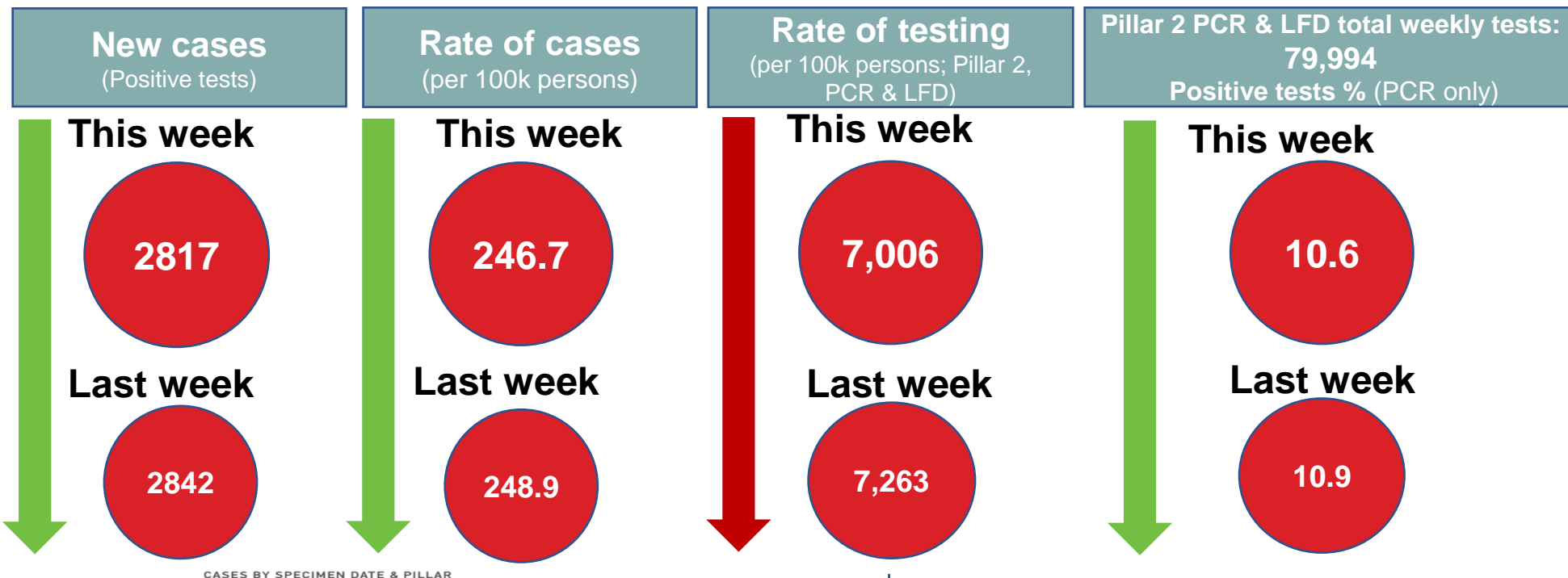

New cases and the overall case rate have decreased in the 7 days leading up to 26th September. The % of positive PCR tests has also decreased, along with overall testing rates using PCR, LFD or both.

All adults are encouraged to do regular home testing using the rapid Lateral flow tests. The test kits are available at community pharmacies [across the city](#), or you can also order online for home delivery directly from the government for [free by post](#).

Spread appears to be primarily occurring through household, social and workplace interactions. Spread often happens in the home but it isn't inevitable, and www.germdefence.org can help.

In hospitals across the city, admissions range between 16 and 47 new cases a day in the week ending 26th September (total = 211), a decrease of 4.5% when compared to last week's admissions ranging between 24 and 45 new daily cases (total = 221). There were 13 deaths reported this week in Birmingham, an increase of 8 deaths compared to the previous week.

This week, cases across Birmingham decreased to 2,817 cases, compared to 2,842 cases reported the previous week, a decrease of 0.9%.

The 10 wards with the highest case rates (cases per 100,000 population) this week are:

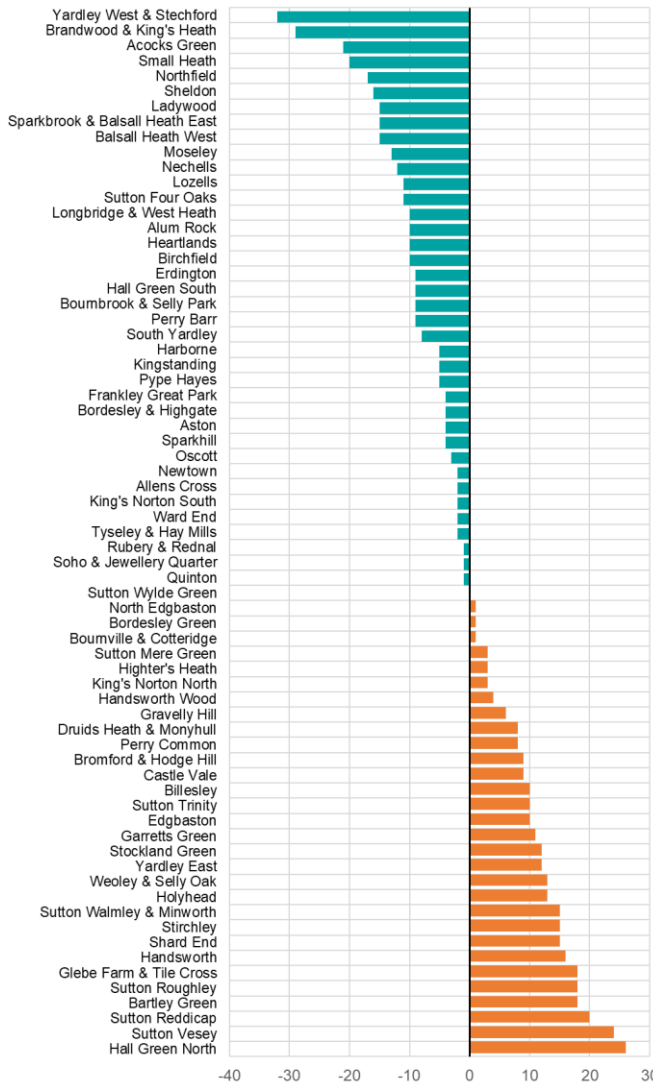

Cases decreased in all age groups this week, except 10-19 (20.9% increase), 40-49 (6.8% increase) and 80+ (5.1% increase).

Cases increased in all ethnic groups except the Black ethnic group, with the largest increase in the Mixed/Other ethnic group, which increased by 19.9%.

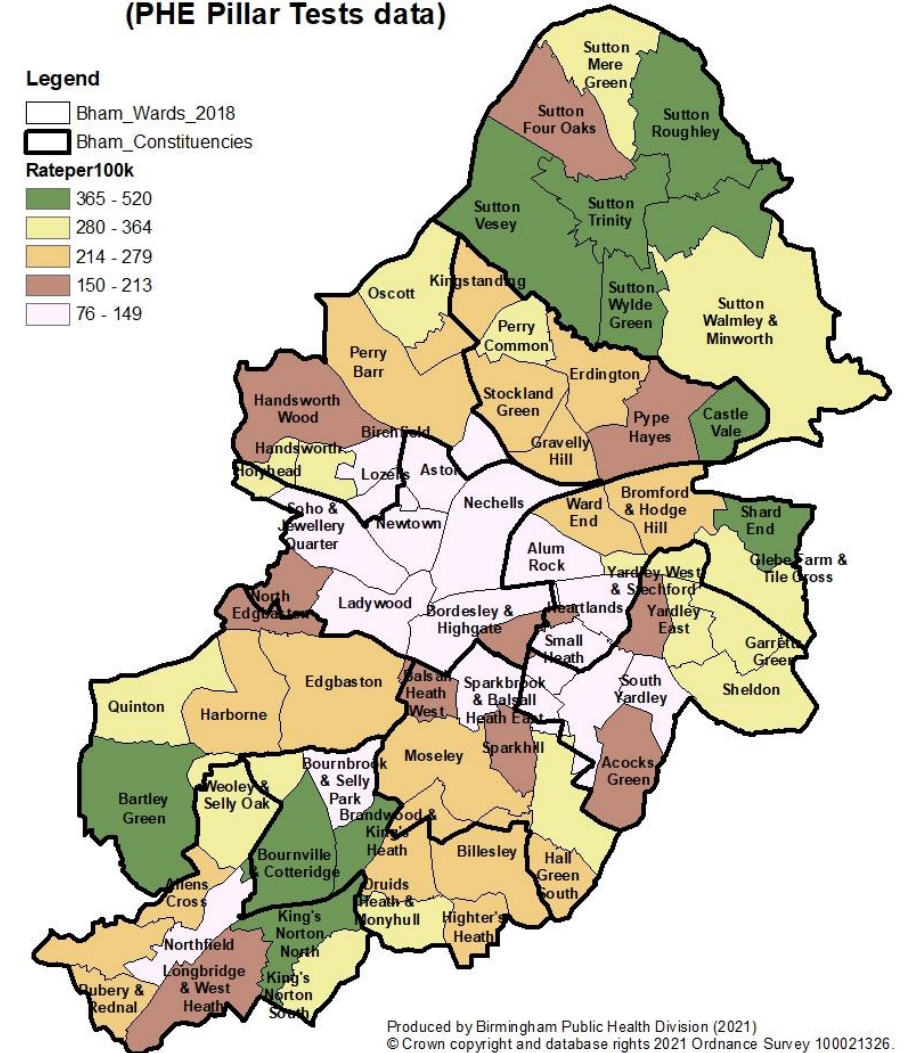

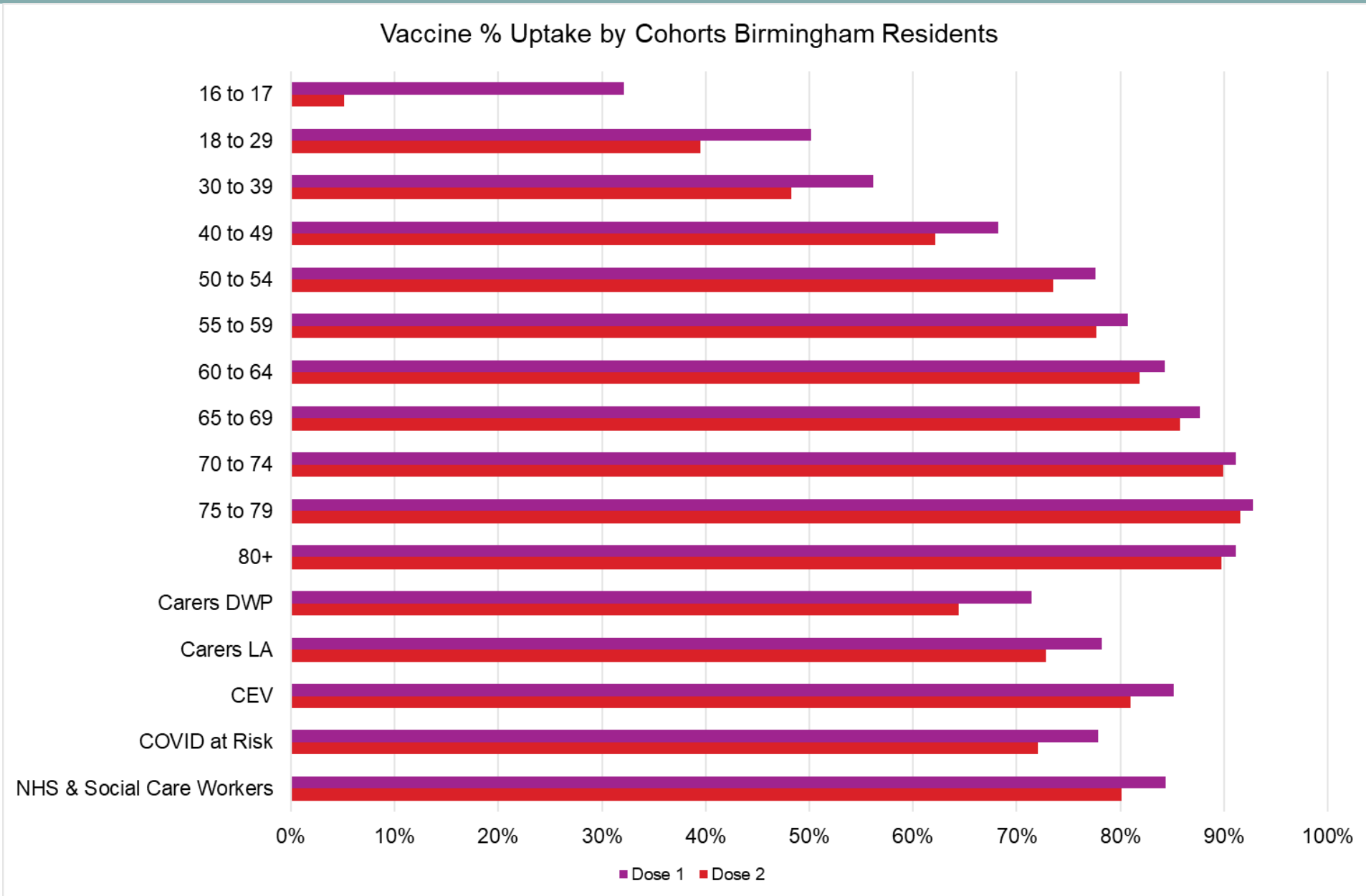
