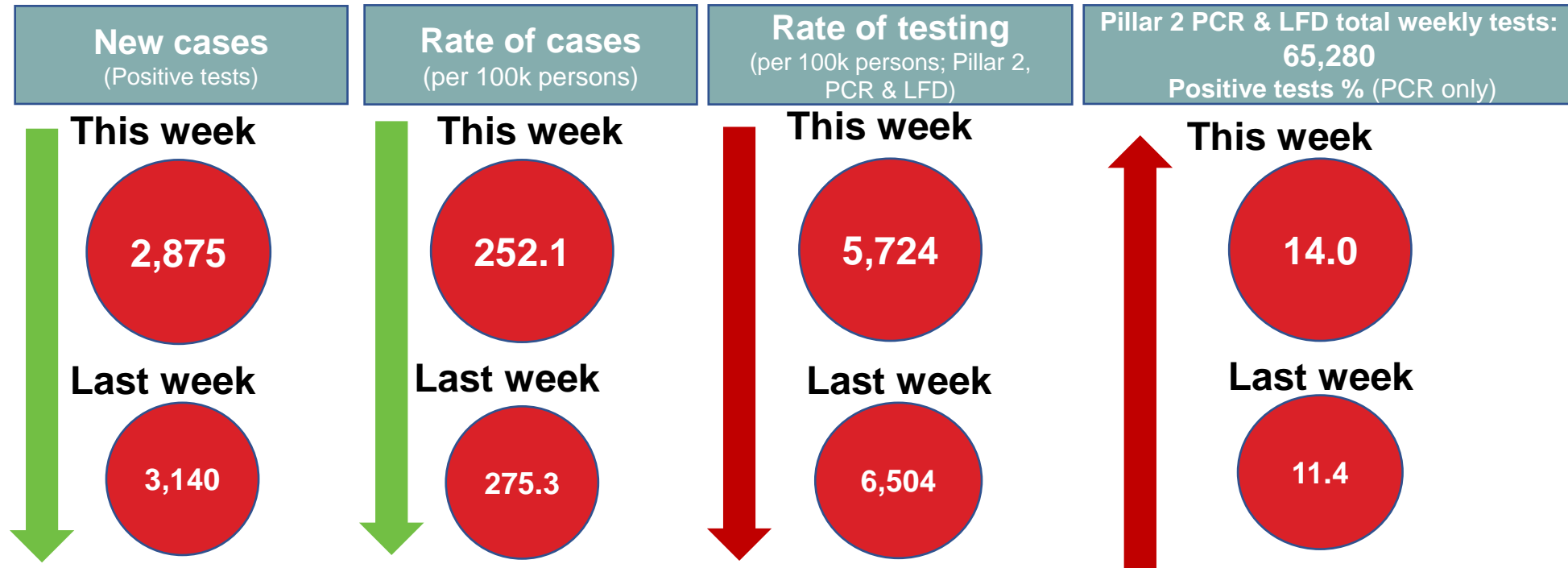

New cases and the overall case rate have decreased in the 7 days leading up to 7th November. The % of positive PCR tests has increased, but the overall testing rates using PCR and LFD has decreased.

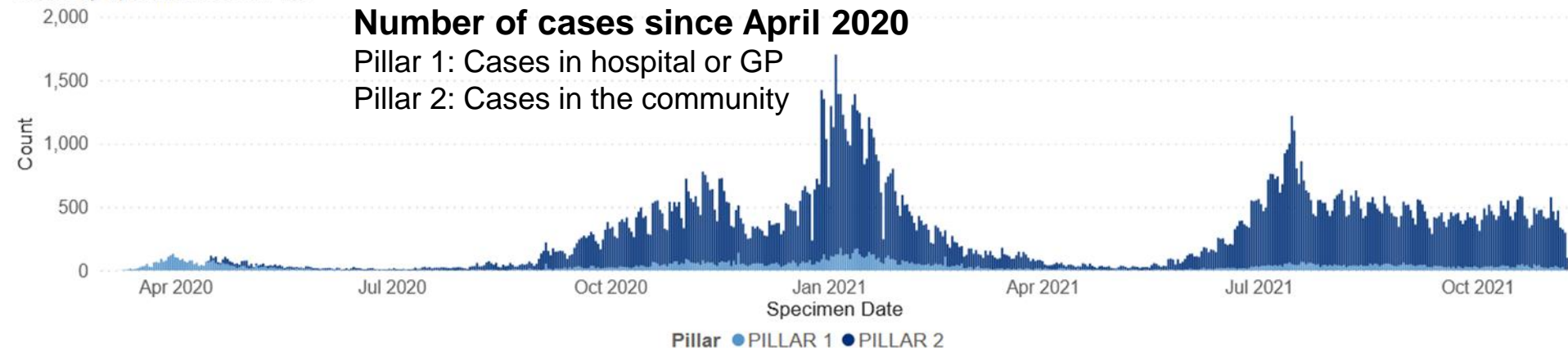
All adults are encouraged to do regular home testing using the rapid Lateral flow tests. The test kits are available at community pharmacies [across the city](#), or you can also order online for home delivery directly from the government for [free by post](#).

Spread appears to be primarily occurring through household, social and workplace interactions. Spread often happens in the home but it isn't inevitable, and www.germdefence.org can help.

In hospitals across the city, admissions ranged between 22 and 34 new cases a day in the week ending 7th November (total = 189), a decrease of 8% when compared to last week's admissions of between 18 and 39 new daily cases (total = 206). There were 8 deaths reported this week in Birmingham, the same as last week.

Weekly report 1st to 7th November 2021

This week, cases across Birmingham decreased to 2,875 cases, compared to 3,140 cases reported the previous week, a decrease of 8.4%.

The 10 wards with the highest case rates (cases per 100,000 population) this week are:

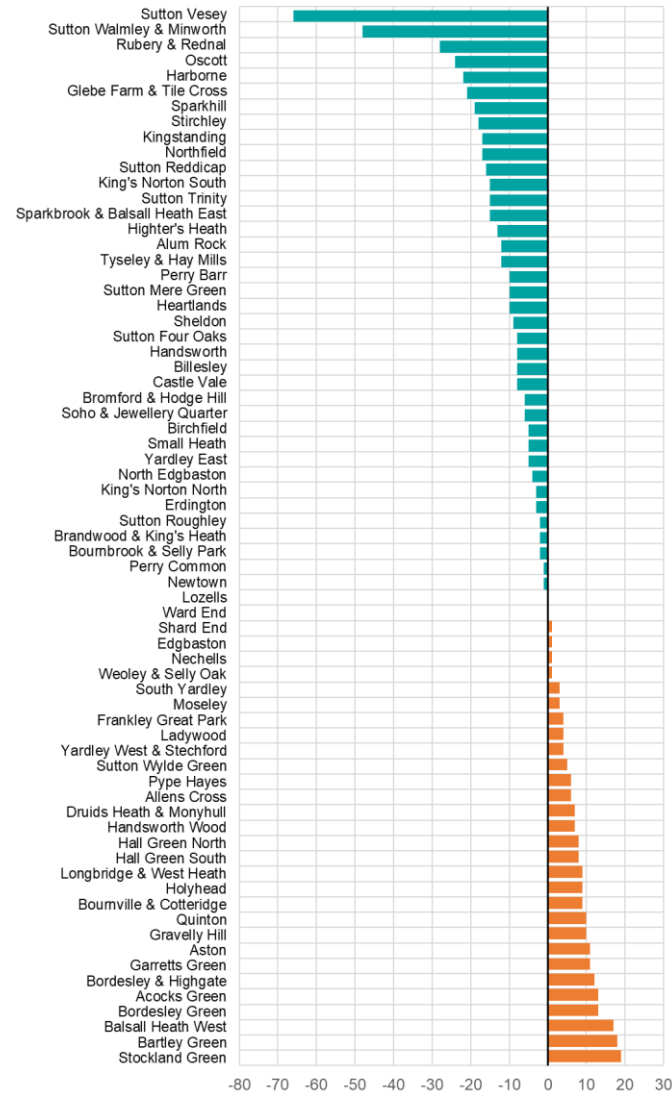

Cases decreased in all age groups this week, except the 20-39 and 40-59 age groups, which increased by 11% and 3% respectively.

Cases decreased in all ethnic groups, except the Asian ethnic group, which increased by 7%.

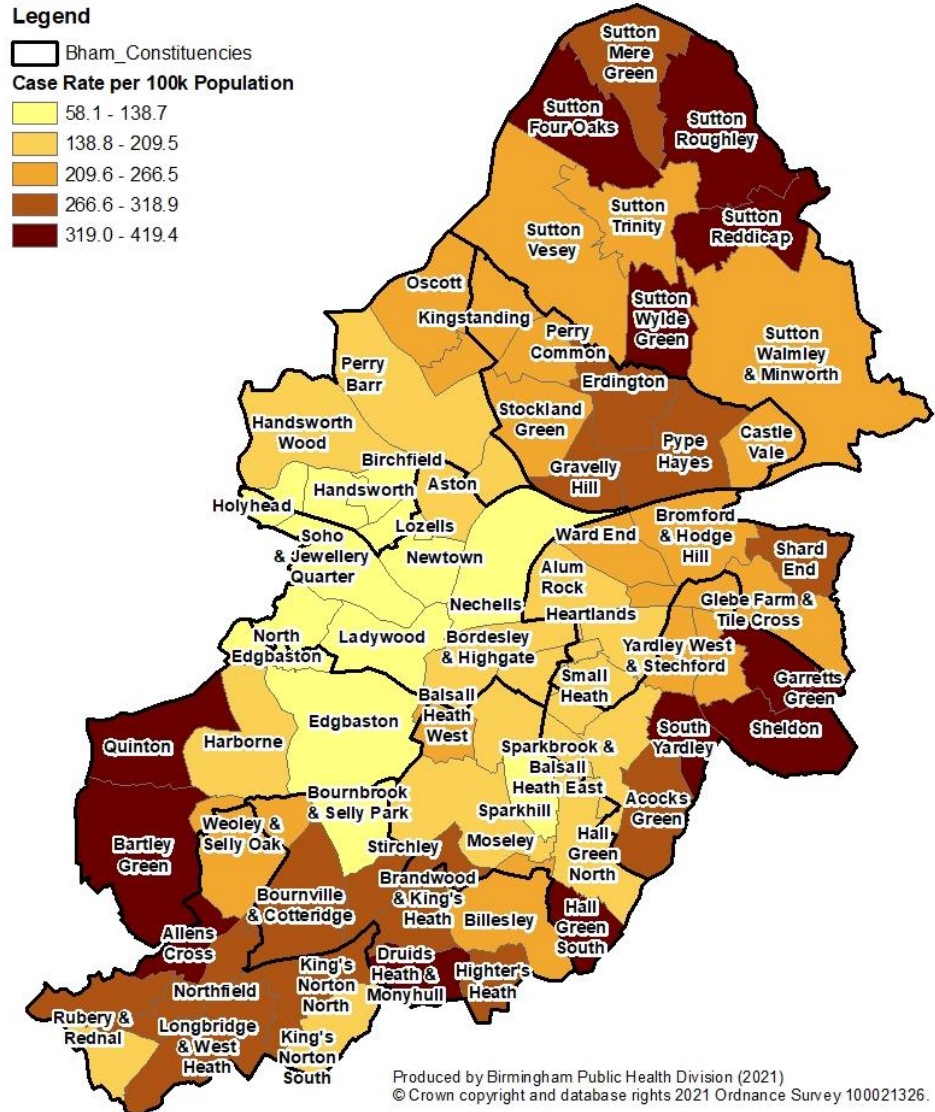

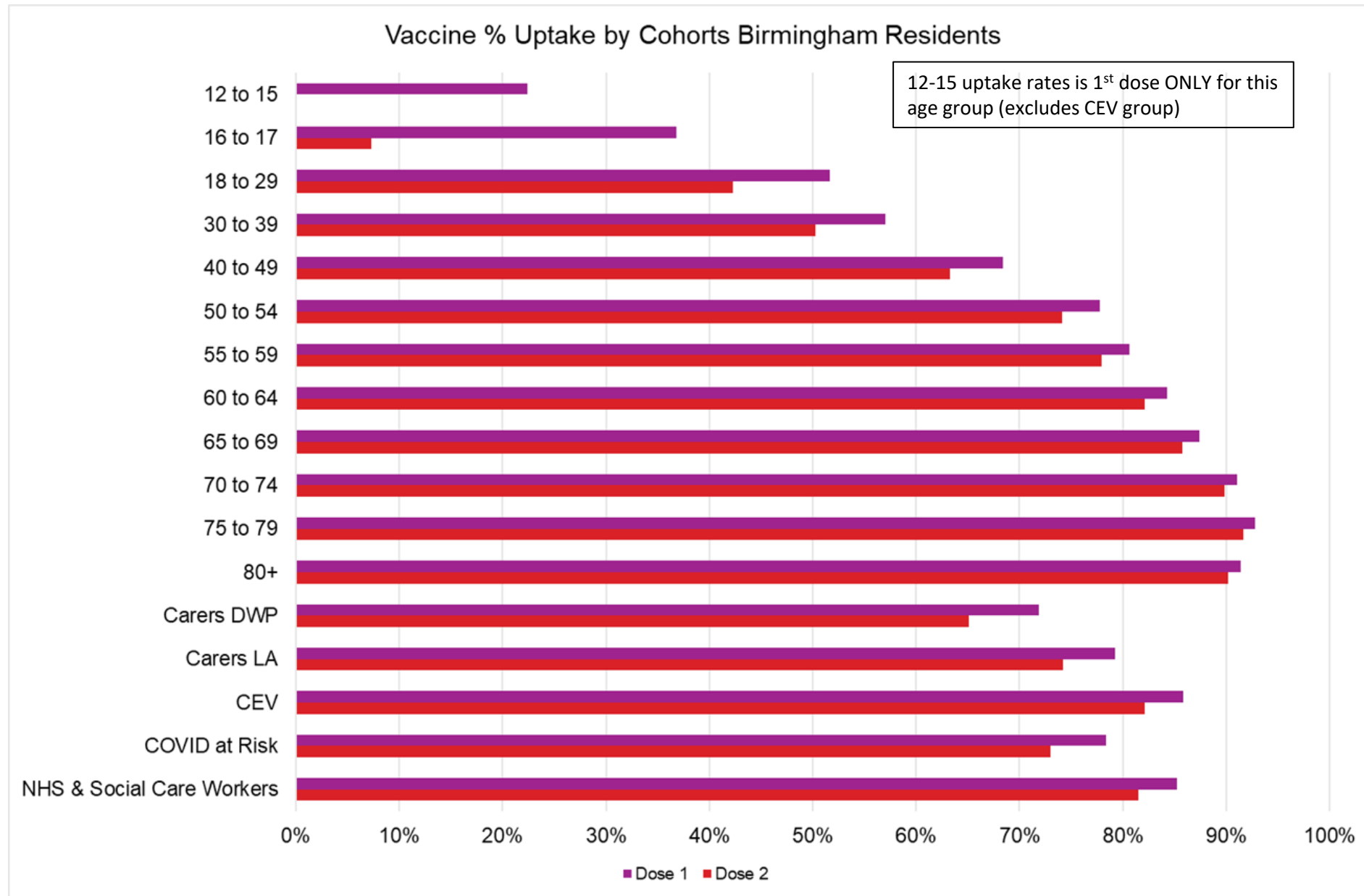
