## **Review of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report 2021- 2022**

### **1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 The Police and Crime Panel has a statutory duty to review the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report at a public meeting and make a report to the Commissioner.

### **2. Recommendation**

**That the Police and Crime Panel receive and review the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report 2020-2021.**

### **3. Background and Panel Statutory Responsibilities**

- 3.1 Under the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Police and Crime Commissioner is required to produce and publish an Annual Report on:
- the exercise of the PCC's functions in each financial year, and
  - the progress which has been made in the financial year in meeting the objectives contained in the PCC's Police and Crime Plan.
- 3.2 Under the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Police and Crime Panel must:
- Arrange for a public meeting to be held as soon as practicable after the Panel is sent an annual report,
  - Ask the PCC at that meeting such questions about the annual report as the members of the Panel think appropriate,
  - Review the annual report, and
  - Make a report or recommendations on the annual report to the PCC.

### **4. Annual Report 2020-2021**

- 4.1 In May 2021, Simon Foster was elected as West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner. The Annual Report 2020- 2021, however, covers the period April 2020 to March 2021, when David Jamieson was PCC, and reflects the work undertaken in meeting the strategic priorities contained in Mr Jamieson's Police and Crime Plan 2016-2021.

- 4.3 Members are asked to consider the Annual Report and agree a collective response. The PCC is then required to respond to any recommendations made by the Panel.
