In the 7 days up to 15th January, new cases significantly decreased, along with the overall case rate. In the 7 days up to 14th January both the % positive PCR tests and the testing rates using PCR and LFD have significantly decreased.

All adults are encouraged to do regular home testing using the rapid Lateral Flow Tests. The test kits are available at community pharmacies and council collection points [across the city](#), or you can also order online for home delivery directly from the government for [free by post](#).

In hospitals across the city, admissions ranged between 73 and 119 new cases a day in the week ending 15th January (total = 690), an increase of 6% when compared to last week's admissions of between 63 and 127 new daily cases (total = 654). There were 22 deaths reported this week in Birmingham, a decrease compared to 26 deaths reported in the previous week.

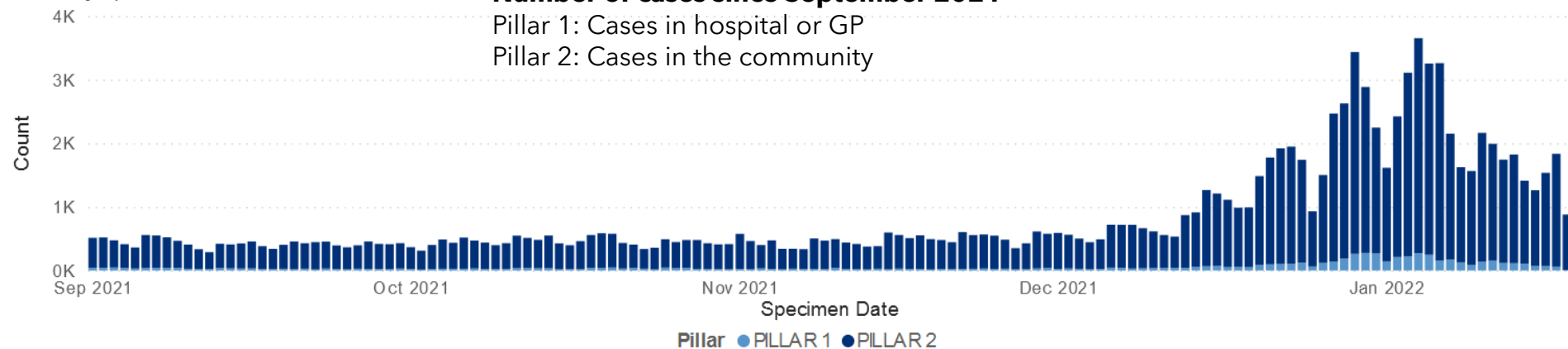

Weekly Report 9th to 15th January 2022

This week, the total number of cases identified in Birmingham was 11,964 cases, compared to 19,481 cases reported in the previous week, an decrease of 38.6%.

The 10 wards with the highest case rates (cases per 100,000 population) this week are:

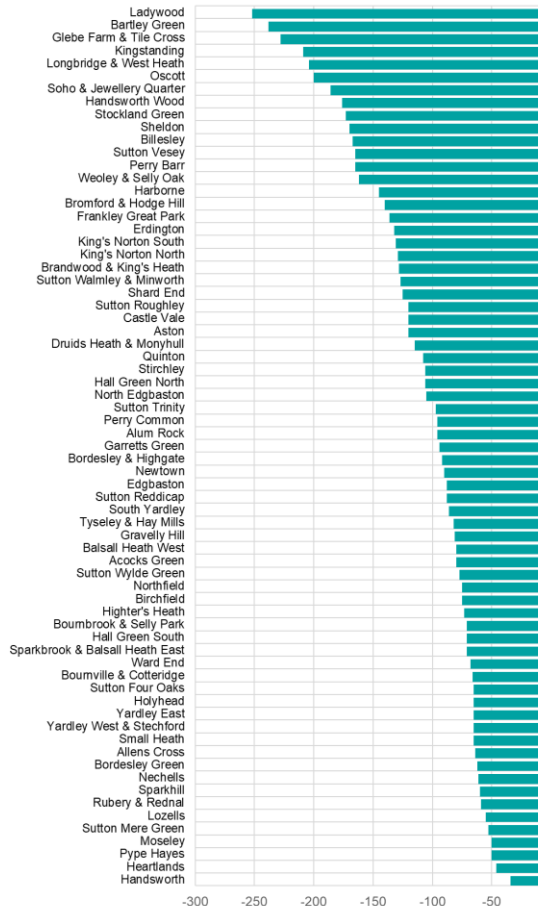
- Castle Vale (1,451.1)
- Yardley East (1,395.5)
- Allens Cross (1,375.9)
- Acocks Green (1,369.5)
- Brandwood & King's Heath (1,335.1)
- Pype Hayes (1,324.6)
- Garretts Green (1,318.2)
- Sparkbrook & Balsall Heath East (1,314.2)
- Bournville & Cotteridge (1,294.3)
- Frankley Great Park (1,288.7)

Compared to previous week, cases decreased in all age groups this week. The largest decrease was 49%, in the 60-79 age group, followed by decreases of 48% in 20-39 and 46% in 40-59. The 0-19 age group showed the smallest decrease of 11%, and this age group accounted for 34% of all cases.

Cases decreased in all ethnic groups this week. The Black ethnic group showed the largest decrease of 45%, followed by decreases of 44% in the White ethnic group, 32% in the Mixed/Other group, and 26% in the Asian ethnic group.

Change in weekly cases compared to the previous week

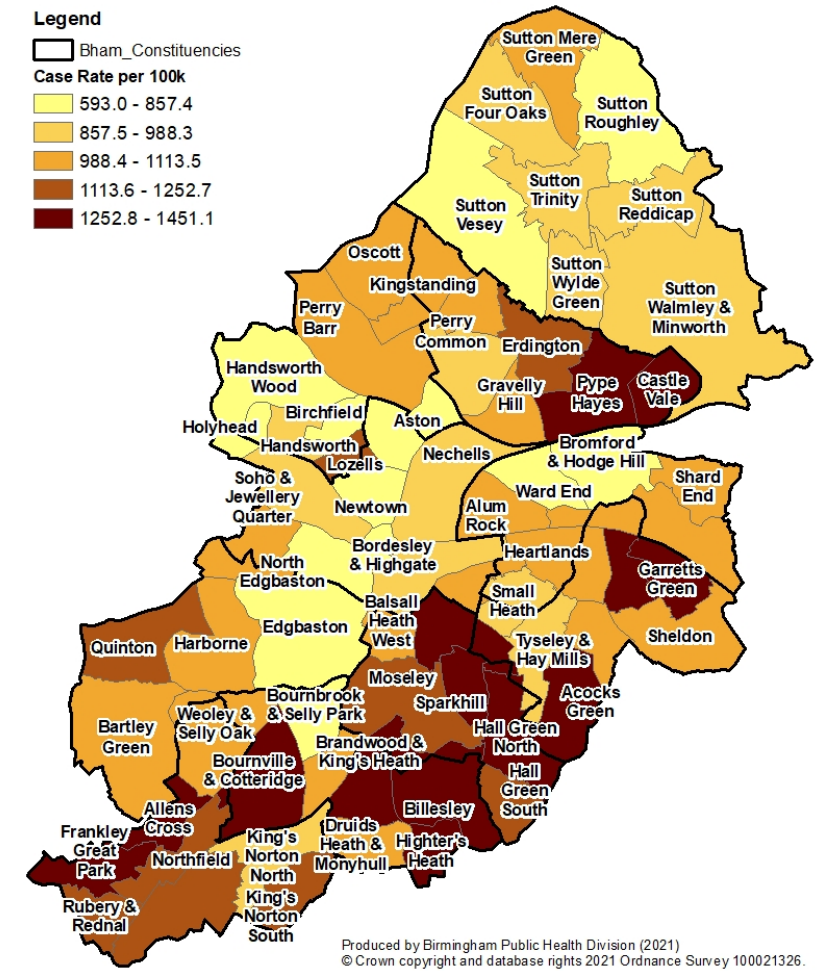
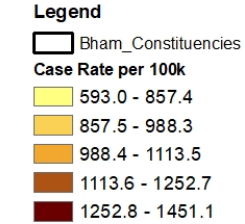


Comparison of seven-day total cases from 08 Jan to 15 Jan by ward level covering Birmingham.

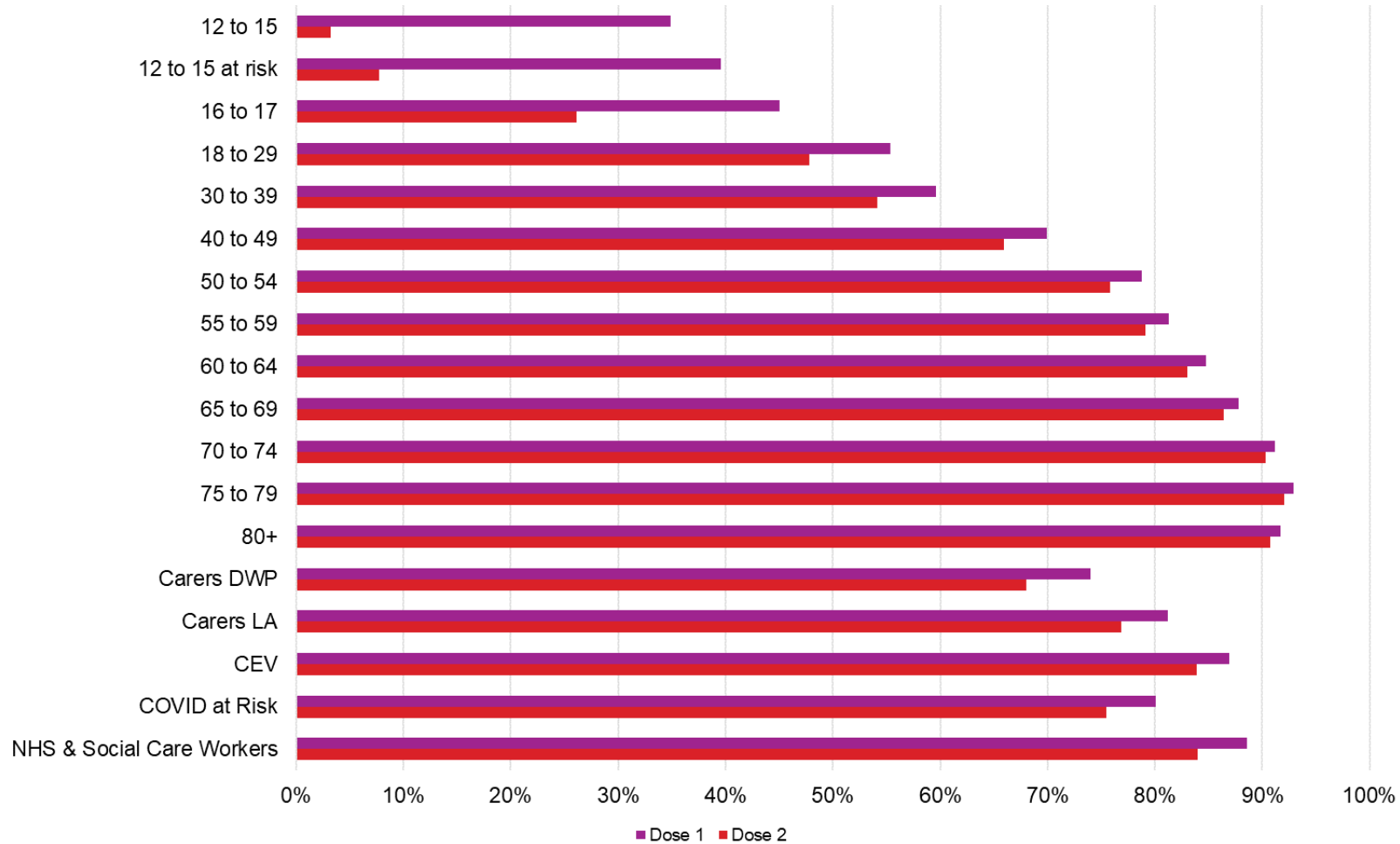

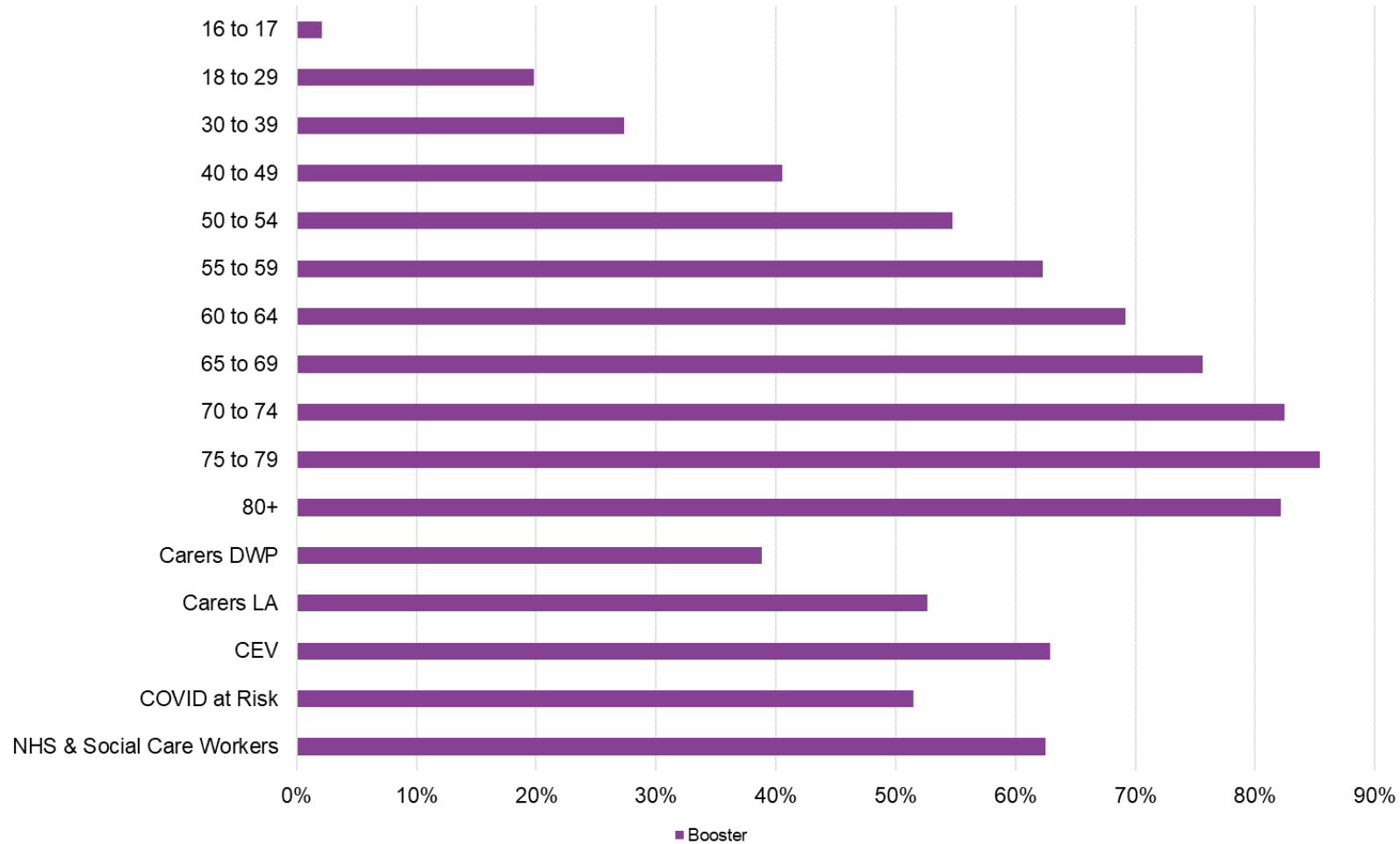
Vaccine 1st and 2nd % Uptake by Cohorts Birmingham Residents
