Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this by election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Elections Office, Room Y19, Council House Extension, Margaret Street B3 3BU by 5pm on Thursday 3 March 2022.
