4. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the offices of Birmingham City Council, at the address shown below, on any working day after the date of this notice, during normal office hours but no later than 4pm on Tuesday 5 April 2022.
5. If any election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 5 May 2022 between the hours of 7:00am and 10:00pm
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 Midnight on Thursday 14 April 2022.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by 5pm on Tuesday 19 April 2022 if they are to be effective for this election.
8. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy or emergency proxy) must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2022.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by 5pm on Thursday 5 May 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2022.
