

CARE FEES 2023/2024

The following fees will apply to all new and existing packages of care with contracted providers under the following contracts, from Monday 3 April 2023 (or from date of contract award, whichever is the latter).

For the avoidance of doubt, existing packages of care (commissioned under 2018 care home, supported living or home support sensory loss contracts) will not be uplifted to the fees set out below until the care provider has been awarded a 2023 care home, supported living or home support sensory loss contract, which are scheduled to be retendered in January 2023:

- The following fees will apply to all new and existing packages of care with contracted providers, from Monday 3 April 2023 (or from date of contract award, whichever is the latter):
- There is a Guide Price in place which operates under 6 price bands dependent on a care hours assessment of the citizen's unmet eligible care and support needs.
- You may be required to submit an Open Book template as part of this process.

Notes:

- 1. Placements outside of Birmingham For Out of Area care home placements commissioned at the host local authority fee the Council will pay the associated increase once this is determined by the host local authority and once the provider has been awarded the Council's 2023 Flexible Contracting Arrangement only. For out of area placements commissioned at the Birmingham standard residential fee or Birmingham standard nursing fee then the fees will increase to £622 and £715 respectively, again once the provider has been awarded the Council's 2023 Flexible Contracting Arrangement only.
- 2. Care Home Block Contracts Fees will increase from 3 April 2023 by 8.66% (excluding FNC).
- 3. Interim Beds Fees will increase from 3 April 2023 by 8.66% (excluding FNC equivalent payment).
- 4. Enhanced Assessment Beds Fees will increase from 3 April 2023 by 8.66% (excluding FNC).
- 5. **Extra Care Sheltered Housing** Fees will increase as follows:
 - a. Spot purchased Extra Care hours will increase to £17.79/hour from 3 April 2023.
 - b. Block contracted Extra Care hours will increase to £15.50/hour from 3 April 2023.
- 6. **Externally Commissioned Day Opportunities** Fees will increase from 3 April 2023 by 8.7%.
- 7. **Direct Payments** All existing Direct Payments as at 3 April 2023 will increase by 8.3% with any new Direct Payments entered into on or after 3 April 2023 being paid as follows:
 - a. Use of a personal assistant will increase by 8.3% to £12.45/hour
 - b. Use of a CQC Registered care provider will increase by 8.3% to £17.79/hour
- 8. **Non-Contracted Providers** These fees or associated increases do not apply to providers not commissioned under the above named arrangements and/or contracts.
- For providers who do not apply for/not awarded a 2023 contract (care homes, supported living or home support sensory loss) – please note there will be no increase in your fees until such time as you are awarded a 2023 contract.
