If you are an estate agent interested in letting your properties in Birmingham or in surrounding areas, Birmingham City Council is offering a financial package of **£3,000 to £4,000** to support Ukrainians living in Birmingham under the Homes for Ukraine scheme to move on, into private rented accommodation.

- ✓ £3,000-£4,000 funding available via BCC
- ✓ Rent Guarantors
- ✓ Leave to remain status for Ukrainians
- Outreach Tenancy support from Spring Housing

Birmingham City Council Move on Offer for Homes for Ukraine guests

Our offer includes the following:

- Financial support package on offer from Birmingham City Council to help Ukrainians move on into their independent accommodation.
- Direct Funding available to those on the Homes for Ukraine scheme for £3,000-£4,000, to enable them to move into private rented properties.
- Funding can be utilised right away to help pay holding deposits fees, months upfront of rent in advance, tenancy deposits schemes as well as buying furniture etc.
- Scheme is funded by Birmingham City Council and managed by Spring Housing who will ensure tenants can access the funding as soon as they've located a property on the market.
- Outreach tenancy Support is provided to help tenants set up all their utility bills, start and maintain their tenancies.
