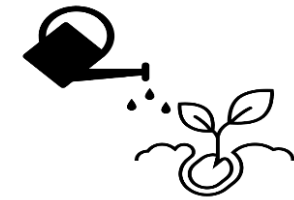
Making a positive difference everyday to people's lives



Part 4 of the Domestic Abuse Act 2021 places a new duty on local authorities to ensure that all victims of domestic abuse have access to the right support within safe accommodation when they need it. In April 2021, as a tier one authority, Birmingham City Council was allocated £3.2m funding (12 months only) to fulfil this role.

As well as enhancing commissioned domestic abuse services and support within Birmingham, the funding looked to address other areas of need identified in Birmingham's Domestic Abuse Needs Assessment.
