BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (BARKER STREET & HUNTERS ROAD, LOZELLS) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2023

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9, 10(1) and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Barker Street & Hunters Road, Lozells) (Prohibition of Entry) (Experimental) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the 10th day of August Two thousand and twenty three.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter the road or length of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule at the point specified in column 2 in the direction specified in column 3 subject to any exemptions, if any, specified in column 4.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.


