


4,050 Bangladeshi people live in Lozells; nearly 10% (8.37%) of the whole community and 33% of the ward's total population.

OVER

81% of those who identify as Bangladeshi in Birmingham hold a UK passport. Additionally, 8% have a Bangladeshi passport and 4% have no passport.



COUNTRY OF BIRTH

58% of the Bangladeshi community based in Birmingham noted the UK as the country of birth, compared to 57% in 2011.

18,966 people in Birmingham noted Bangladesh as their country of birth.

MIGRATION

From 2011 to 2021 around 6,539 Birmingham-based Bangladeshis migrated to the UK.



This is an increase when compared with 2001 to 2011 (4,431).

70% of the Bangladeshi community speak English as their main language. This is compared to 84% of the Birmingham population. 14% cannot speak English well or at all.








