Brief description of the	Film Birmingham is a one-stop support service for film and
policy, service or function	tv production companies filming in the city. The proposal is
covered by the EIA	to make the service cost neutral by cutting expenditure and increasing income (Fees & Charges). Current net cost to the city is £0.089pa but the service generates up to £0.200m income pa for other council service areas including parking, highways, parks and property services. Approx £0.035 expenditure cuts planned incl. cut to marketing budget, supplies budget, sponsorship of sector related events and supporting training and skills programmes.
