DEFINING THE POPULATION



GAY REFERS TYPICALLY TO MEN WHO ARE PRIMARILY ATTRACTED, ROMANTICALLY **&/OR SEXUALLY, TO OTHER MEN.** THE ACRONYM MSM PRIMARILY DENOTES DO NOT IDENTIFY AS GAY OR BISEXUAL BUT WHO HAVE SEX WITH OTHER MEN.


