

Aston Resident Parking Scheme

Resident Parking Permits - Available to residents only

Resident permits are available for residents who live in the areas shown within the lines on the map below (the scheme area).

The parking permits are valid for use on Match Days only.

There is no charge for permits and residents may apply for 2 permits per residence.

There is no expiry date on the permits.

Residents will need to apply for replacement permits in the event of loss of or damage to permits, for which an admin charge will be made.

Permits are only valid for use in the designated resident permit bays within the scheme area.

Conditions of issue

- 1. A resident permit will only be issued once the following evidence has been uploaded:
 - proof of residency (such as Council Tax or recent utility bill showing your name and address in the scheme area)
- 2. A permit may be withdrawn if it has not been used according to the conditions of issue.
- 3. The permit is only valid for use in the designated resident permit parking bays within the scheme area and may be used only by residents and their visitors. It must be displayed by hanging it from the rear-view mirror on the front windscreen of the vehicle.
- 4. The permit will become invalid if the applicant no longer resides within the scheme area. It must be returned to the council.
- 5. A permit may be purchased for the following classes of vehicle:
 - passenger vehicles
 - goods vehicles not exceeding 5 tonnes maximum gross weight
 - motorcycles
- 6. An admin charge will be made for the replacement of a stolen or damaged permit, or replacement of a lost permit. All charges are subject to annual review.
- 7. A permit will be rendered invalid if any alterations are made and may be withdrawn in accordance with item 2 above.
- 8. A permit does not guarantee availability of a parking space
- 9. The council reserves the right to refuse the issue of a permit
- 10. The council reserves the right to withdraw the permit(s)
