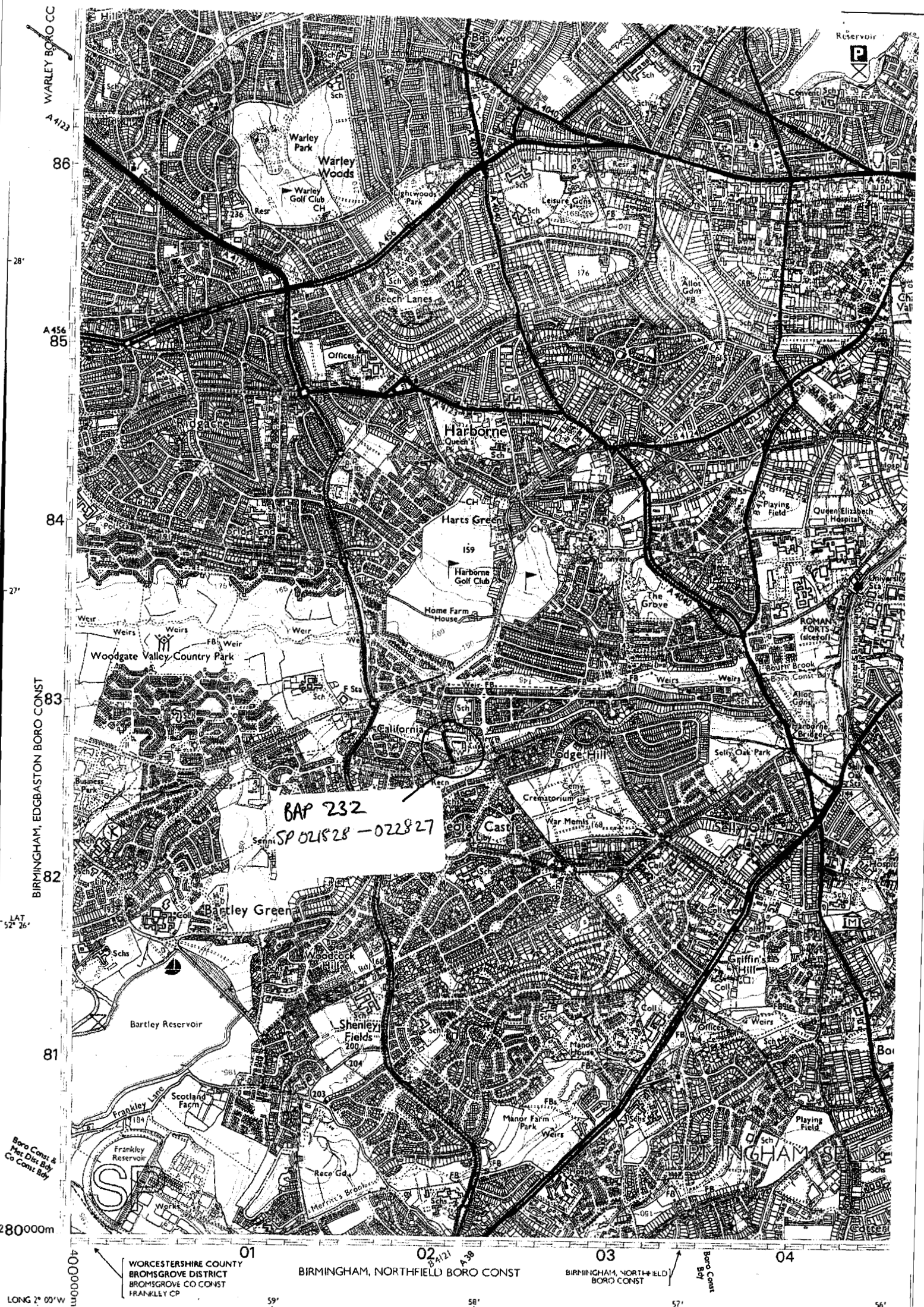

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 232

- 1 The original path is first shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch map.
- 2 The original path was closed by diversion onto a new street (Alwold Road) by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order with a Certificate of Completion dated 27 January 1934, from a Sessions held on 2 May 1932. The Order, however, retained the former accommodation road south from Somery Road as a public footpath, being an essential link in the path network. (The Order is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library at QS/B/21/2 (Box 15, item 17.)
- 3 The retained path has a tarmac surface, with modern street lights.
- 4 The claimed route is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 5 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
