

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 17

- The whole of the original path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The section from Brandwood Park Road to the canal was diverted by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order with a Certificate dated 16 January 1937. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library, Archives section, at QS/B/21/2 (Box 15, item 12).)
- The section between Brandwood Road and Brandwood Park Road was under development at the time of the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 sheet SP07, published in 1952, although no Highways Order has been found.
- The remaining section of the path is partly paved and is freely accessible.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
