Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 281

- The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Copy held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- 2 The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The Ordnance Survey Pathfinder map (sheet 954 of 1988) shows alleyways approximately on the line of the original path from Hazel Croft east to Kingshurst Road, and then east to Church Hill, Northfield. (No Diversion Order has been located.)
- Both sections of the path are paved, with street lamps and bollards. One of the lamps is old, the other new.
- 5 The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
