

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 258

- The path id first recorded on the map with the Kings Norton (Moundsley Yield) Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library,)
- The path is also shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The Ordnance Survey 'Pathfinder' map, sheet 954, of 1988 shows the same route, but with a diversion at the north end, following (in part) Clandon Close. No Diversion Order, however, has been located.
- A site visit has shown that the north end of the path, shown as an enclosed route by the school on the above map, no longer exists and appears to have been replaced by a link from Keywell Court to Clandon Close. No Diversion, or Closure, Order has been located.
- This section of the path, and that from Clandon Close to Bells Lane, are surfaced with tarmac and paving slabs and both have modern street lights.
- The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
